

GLOSSARY OF TECHNICAL TERMS

This glossary of technical terms contains explanations of certain technical terms used in this document as they relate to our Company and as they are used in this document in connection with our business or us. Such terminology and meanings may not correspond to standard industry meanings or usages of those terms.

“ATM”	automated teller machine, a basic self-service financial device for core banking services such as cash deposit and withdrawal, fund transfer and account inquiry, widely deployed in smart financial branches
“CAGR”	compound annual growth rate, the rate of annual growth that compounds over a specified period
“CB”	a certification scheme under the IECEE CB System, facilitating mutual recognition of national safety certifications among participating countries and regions for electrical and electronic products
“CCC”	China compulsory product certification, a mandatory safety certification system administered by the relevant PRC authorities for products included in the catalogue of compulsory certification within the PRC
“CE”	Conformité Européenne, a conformity marking indicating that a product complies with applicable EU health, safety and environmental protection requirements, allowing free circulation within the European Economic Area
“CIF”	cost, insurance and freight, an international trade term where the seller covers cost, freight and insurance to the destination port
“CKD”	completely knocked down a mode of local overseas assembly using fully disassembled parts
“CPS”	characters per second, a unit of measurement for print speed
“DPI”	dots per inch, a unit of measurement for print resolution and scanning accuracy
“EMC”	electromagnetic compatibility, the ability of equipment to operate without disruptive electromagnetic interference
“EMR”	electromagnetic resonance technology, used in electromagnetic screens, including passive pen, sensing, signal processing and control
“ERP”	enterprise resource planning, an integrated information system for managing finance, human resources, inventory and production
“EXW”	ex-works, an international trade term where the buyer bears all transport costs and risks from the seller’s premises
“FOB”	free on board, an international trade term where risk passes when goods are loaded on board the vessel at the port of shipment
“ISO”	International Organisation for Standardisation, a set of international standards including ISO 9001 (quality) and ISO 14001 (environmental management)

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“IWB”	interactive whiteboard
“MICR”	magnetic ink character recognition, technology for identifying magnetic ink characters on financial documents and cheques
“MTBF”	mean time between failures, a key indicator measuring equipment reliability
“NRTL”	nationally recognised testing laboratory certification, a product safety certification for the U.S. and Canadian markets
“OCR”	optical character recognition, technology that converts image text into machine-readable digital data
“Passbook Printer”	a specialised dot-matrix printer for financial passbooks, bills and certificates
“PCB”	printed circuit board, a board used to connect and mount electronic components
“Print head”	the core component that performs dot-matrix printing
“RFID”	radio frequency identification, a contactless automatic identification and data capture technology
“SKD”	semi-knocked down, a mode of local overseas assembly using semi-disassembled kits
“SMT”	surface mount technology, a production process for mounting electronic components onto printed circuit boards
