

GLOSSARY

This glossary of technical terms contains explanations of certain technical terms used in this Document. As such, these terms and their meanings may not correspond to standard industry meanings or usage of these terms.

“Aggregation Platforms”	third-party mobility map and local services platforms, through which riders can access ride-hailing services offered by multiple mobility service providers. These platforms primarily serve as traffic entry points and interface channels, while the underlying ride-hailing services are provided by the relevant mobility service providers
“AI”	artificial intelligence
“CAGR”	compound annual growth rate
“GTV”	gross transaction value of all ride-hailing orders completed on our platform during the relevant period, without adjustment of applicable incentives, taxes, tolls, or fees
“large scale mobility platforms”	smart mobility platforms with an average monthly ride-hailing order volume of over 30 million orders during the period from 2023 to 2025
“NEV(s)”	new energy vehicle(s), which uses alternative fuel sources such as electricity, hydrogen or hybrid powertrains
“OEMs”	original equipment manufacturers, which assemble and install automotive parts during the construction of a new vehicle
“Robotaxi”	an autonomous vehicle designed to provide driverless taxi services to passengers
“smart mobility”	transportation service that integrates mobility services with the Internet and utilizes advanced technologies, such as artificial intelligence, autonomous driving, and cloud computing, to enhance the efficiency, safety and user experience of mobility services
“VDR”	vehicle data recorder
