OVERVIEW

As of the Latest Practicable Date, the issued share capital of our Company was RMB10,532,417, comprising 10,532,417 Unlisted Shares with a nominal value of RMB1 each.

Immediately prior to the [REDACTED], pursuant to the Share Subdivision, the ordinary shares of the Company will be split on a one for ten basis, and the registered share capital of our Company will be RMB10,532,417, comprising 105,324,170 Unlisted Shares in issue of nominal value RMB0.10 each.

- (1) Following the completion of the [REDACTED], [REDACTED] Unlisted Shares held by our existing Shareholders will be converted into H Shares on a one-for-one basis and [REDACTED] on the Stock Exchange for trading. Filing of such conversion of Unlisted Shares into H shares has been completed with the CSRC on [•], 2026. RANKING

Upon completion of the [REDACTED], we would have only one class of Shares, i.e. the H Shares, which are ordinary Shares in the share capital of our Company. However, apart from certain qualified domestic institutional investors in the PRC, the qualified PRC investors under the Shanghai – Hong Kong Stock Connect or the Shenzhen – Hong Kong Stock Connect and other persons who are entitled to hold our H Shares pursuant to relevant PRC laws and regulations or upon approvals of any competent authorities, H Shares generally cannot be subscribed for by or traded between legal or natural persons of the PRC.

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Unlisted Shares and H Shares will rank *pari passu* with each other in all respects and, in particular, will rank equally for all dividends or distributions declared, paid or made after the date of this Document. All dividends in respect of the H Shares are to be paid by us in Hong Kong dollars or in the form of H Shares.

CONVERSION OF OUR UNLISTED SHARES INTO H SHARES

The Company has filed for a “full circulation” of all the existing 105,324,170 Unlisted Shares into H Shares on a one-for-one basis, taking into account the Share Subdivision, and submitted the application reports, authorization documents of the shareholders of Unlisted Shares for which an H-share “full circulation” are applied, explanation about the compliance of share acquisition and other documents in accordance with the requirements of the CSRC.

The relevant filings of the conversion of the existing 105,324,170 Unlisted Shares (taking into account the Share Subdivision) held by the existing Shareholders into H Shares on a one-for-one basis have been completed on [•].

Upon completion of the [REDACTED], if any of our Shares are not [REDACTED] or [REDACTED] on any stock exchange, the holders of our Unlisted Shares may convert their Shares into H Shares provided such conversion shall have gone through any requisite internal approval process and complied with the regulations prescribed by the securities regulatory authorities of the State Council and the regulations, requirements and procedures prescribed by the overseas stock exchange(s) and have completed the required filing with the securities regulatory authorities of the State Council, including the CSRC. The [REDACTED] of such converted Shares on the Hong Kong Stock Exchange will also require the approval of the Hong Kong Stock Exchange.

Based on the procedures for the conversion of our Unlisted Shares into H Shares as disclosed in this section, we can apply for the [REDACTED] of all or any portion of our Unlisted Shares on the Hong Kong Stock Exchange as H Shares in advance of any proposed conversion to ensure that the conversion process can be completed promptly upon notice to the Hong Kong Stock Exchange and delivery of Shares for entry on the [REDACTED]. As any [REDACTED] of additional Shares after our [REDACTED] on the Hong Kong Stock Exchange is ordinarily considered by the Hong Kong Stock Exchange to be a purely administrative matter, it will not require such prior application for [REDACTED] at the time of our [REDACTED] in Hong Kong.

No class Shareholder voting is required for the [REDACTED] and trading of the converted Shares on the Hong Kong Stock Exchange. Any application for [REDACTED] of the converted Shares on the Hong Kong Stock Exchange after our [REDACTED] is subject to prior notification by way of announcement to inform Shareholders and the public of such proposed conversion.

After all the requisite approvals have been obtained, the following procedures will need to be completed: the relevant Unlisted Shares will be withdrawn from the Share register and we will re-register such Shares on our [REDACTED] maintained in Hong Kong and instruct the [REDACTED] to issue [REDACTED]. Registration on our [REDACTED] will be on the condition that (a) our [REDACTED] lodges with the Hong Kong Stock Exchange a letter confirming the proper entry of the relevant H Shares on the [REDACTED] of members and the due dispatch of [REDACTED] and (b) the admission of the H Shares to trade on the Hong Kong Stock Exchange

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will comply with the Listing Rules and the General Rules of HKSCC and the HKSCC Operational Procedures in force from time to time. Until the converted Shares are re-registered on our H Share register, such Shares would not be [REDACTED] as H Shares.

GENERAL MANDATE TO ALLOT AND ISSUE SHARES

Subject to the completion of the [REDACTED], pursuant to the Shareholders resolutions of the Company, the Board was granted with a general mandate to allot and issue H Shares (including the sale of treasury Shares) at any time within a period up to the date of the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Shareholders or the date on which the Shareholders pass a resolution to revoke or change such mandate, whichever is the earlier, provided that, the number of Shares to be allotted or issued shall not exceed 20% of the number of the H Shares in issue as of the [REDACTED].
