This glossary contains explanations of certain terms used in this document. These terms and their meanings may or may not correspond to standard industry meanings or usage of these terms.

“AI”	artificial intelligence
“BOSS System”	Business & Operation Support System
“B2B”	business to business, a commerce transaction conducted between one business and another, in which businesses directly sell products or services to various entities and other downstream market players, rather than to consumers
“ERP”	enterprise resource planning
“ESG”	environmental, social and corporate governance responsibilities
“FVTPL”	fair value through profit or loss
“GFA”	gross floor area
“IoT”	internet of things
“sale solution”	it refers to one of the methods to recycle pre-owned consumer electronics by collecting pre-owned consumer electronics without the individual consumers purchasing a new consumer electronic device (閒置回收). Please refer to “Industry Overview” in this document for further details
“trade-in solution”	it refers to one of the methods to recycle pre-owned consumer electronics by collecting pre-owned consumer electronics with the individual consumers using the selling price of such to pay for all or part of a new consumer electronic device (以舊換新).
