CHARACTERISTICS OF GEM OF THE STOCK EXCHANGE

GEM has been positioned as a market designed to accommodate small and mid-sized companies to which a higher investment risk may be attached than other companies listed on the Stock Exchange. Prospective investors should be aware of the potential risks of investing in such companies and should make the decision to invest only after due and careful consideration.

Given that the companies listed on GEM are generally small and mid-sized companies, there is a risk that securities traded on GEM may be more susceptible to high market volatility than securities traded on the Main Board and no assurance is given that there will be a liquid market in the securities traded on GEM.

PRECAUTIONARY MEASURES FOR THE AGM

In view of the ongoing coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic, the Company will implement the following precautionary measures at the AGM to protect attending shareholders, staff and stakeholders from the risk of infection including, without limitation:

- (1) Compulsory temperature checks;
- (2) Submission of health declaration form;
- (3) Wearing of surgical face mask; and
- (4) No provision of corporate gifts, refreshments or drinks.

Any person who does not comply with the precautionary measures, is with a body temperature above 37.2 degree Celsius, has any of the symptoms stated in the health declaration form or is subject to any Hong Kong Government prescribed quarantine may be denied entry into the meeting venue. The Company reminds Shareholders that they may appoint the chairman of the meeting as their proxy to vote on the relevant resolutions at the AGM as an alternative to attending the AGM in person. Subject to the development of COVID-19, the Company may implement further changes and precautionary measures and may issue further announcement on such measures as appropriate.

INTRODUCTION

The purposes of this circular are to (i) provide you with information regarding the proposed Issue Mandate and the proposed Repurchase Mandate; (ii) set out an explanatory statement regarding the Repurchase Mandate; (iii) furnish you with details of the proposed re-election and appointment of Directors; and (iv) give you notice of the AGM.

LETTER FROM THE BOARD

GENERAL MANDATE TO ISSUE SHARES

The Company's existing mandate to issue Shares was approved by its then Shareholders on 10 September 2021. Unless otherwise renewed, the existing mandate to issue Shares will lapse at the conclusion of the AGM. At the AGM, an ordinary resolution will be proposed to grant to the Directors a general and unconditional mandate to allot, issue and otherwise deal with Shares of up to 20% of the total number of Shares in issue as at the date of passing of the proposed resolution.

In addition, a separate ordinary resolution will be proposed at the AGM to add to the Issue Mandate those shares repurchased by the Company pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate (if so granted to the Directors at the AGM).

The Directors have no present intention to exercise the Issue Mandate or the Repurchase Mandate (if granted to the Directors at the AGM).

The Issue Mandate allows the Company to allot, issue and otherwise deal with Shares only during the period ending on the earliest of (i) the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company; (ii) the date by which the next annual general meeting of the Company is required to be held by the Articles of Association or the laws of the Cayman Islands; or (iii) the date upon which such authority is revoked or varied by an ordinary resolution of the Shareholders in a general meeting of the Company (the "**Relevant Period**").

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the issued share capital of the Company comprised 581,442,248 Shares. Subject to the passing of the relevant resolution to approve the Issue Mandate and on the basis that no further Shares are allotted and issued or repurchased prior to the date of the AGM, the Directors would be authorised to allot, issue and otherwise deal with a maximum of 116,288,449 new Shares under the Issue Mandate, representing approximately 20% of the total number of Shares in issue as at the Latest Practicable Date.

GENERAL MANDATE TO REPURCHASE SHARES

The Company's existing mandate to repurchase Shares was approved by its then Shareholders on 10 September 2021. Unless otherwise renewed, the existing mandate to issue Shares will lapse at the conclusion of the AGM.

At the AGM, an ordinary resolution will be proposed to grant to the Directors a general and unconditional mandate to repurchase Shares of up to 10% of the total number of Shares in issue as at the date of passing of the proposed resolution. The Repurchase Mandate will remain in effect during the Relevant Period.

An explanatory statement required to be sent to the Shareholder under the GEM Listing Rules is set out in Appendix I to this circular to provide the requisite information regarding the Repurchase Mandate to the Shareholders.

RE-ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The Board currently consists of seven Directors, namely Mr. Song Xiaoming, Ms. Song Shiqing, Mr. Su Congyue being the executive Directors, Mr. Chung Man Lai being the non-executive Director and Mr. Li Zhongfei, Mr. Zhao Jinsong and Mr. Liu Chengwei being the independent non-executive Directors.

Pursuant to Code Provision B.2.2 of the Corporate Governance Code as set out in Appendix 15 of the GEM Listing Rules, every director, including those appointed for a specific term, should be subject to retirement by rotation at least once every three years. Pursuant to article 108(a) of the Articles of Association, at each AGM, one-third of the Directors for the time being (or, if their number is not a multiple of three, the number nearest to but not less than one-third) shall retire from office by rotation. Accordingly, Mr. Song Xiaoming, Mr. Chung Man Lai and Mr. Zhao Jinsong will retire by rotation at the AGM. Mr. Song Xiaoming, Mr. Chung Man Lai and Mr. Zhao Jinsong, being eligible, have offered themselves for re-election as Directors at the AGM.

For re-election of Mr. Chung Man Lai as non-executive Director, the nomination committee is of the view that, as set out in his biographic details, Mr. Chung will bring his finance experience and perspective to the Board, and his role as a non-executive Director will help improve the operational efficiency of the Board and will be able to provide valuable finance and financial risk management advice to the Company.

The Board considers that Mr. Chung Man Lai has satisfactorily discharged his duties since appointment and believes the re-appointment of Mr. Chung Man Lai would promote diversity of the Board in skills and experience.

In accordance with article 112 of the Articles of Association, Mr. Su Congyue who appointed by the Board as additions to the existing Board shall hold office only until the AGM and, being eligible, has offered themselves for re-election as Directors at the AGM.

The Board received confirmations from Mr. Zhao Jinsong, being the independent non-executive Director eligible for re-election, regarding his independence. Taking into account the factors set out in Rule 5.09 of the GEM Listing Rules, the Board considers that Mr. Zhao Jinsong to be independent. The nomination committee is of the view that, as set out in his biographical details, Mr. Zhao Jinsong in his role as independent non-executive Directors will help to improve the operational efficiency of the Board and will be able to provide valuable legal and compliance advice to the Company.

Brief biographical details of the Directors proposed for re-election are set out in Appendix II to the circular.

NOTICE OF AGM AND PROXY ARRANGEMENT

A notice convening the AGM to be held at Unit 1112, 11/F., The Metropolis Tower, No. 10 Metropolis Drive, Hunghom, Hong Kong on 16 September 2022 (Friday) at 10:00 a.m. is set out on pages 15 to 19 of this circular.

Pursuant to Rule 17.47(4) of the GEM Listing Rules, any vote of Shareholders at a general meeting must be taken by poll except where the chairman, in good faith, decides to allow a resolution which relates purely to a procedural or administrative matter to be voted on by a show of hands.

A form of proxy for use by Shareholders at the AGM is enclosed with this circular. Such form of proxy is also published on the website of the Stock Exchange at www.hkexnews.hk and the Company's website at www.kingforce.com.hk. Whether or not you intend to attend and vote at the AGM in person, you are requested to complete and return the enclosed form of proxy in accordance with the instructions printed thereon and return it to the Company's branch share registrar and transfer office in Hong Kong, Tricor Investor Services Limited at 17/F, Far East Finance Centre, 16 Harcourt Road, Hong Kong as soon as possible but in any event not less than 48 hours before the time appointed for the holding of the AGM or any adjournment thereof (as the case may be). VOTING BY POLL

All the resolutions set out in the notice of the AGM would be decided by poll in accordance with the GEM Listing Rules. The chairman of the AGM would explain the detailed procedures for conducting a poll at the commencement of the AGM.

The poll results will be published on the Company's website at www.kingforce.com.hk and the Stock Exchange's website at www.hkexnews.hk after the conclusion of the AGM.

CLOSURE OF REGISTER OF MEMBERS

The transfer books and register of members of the Company will be closed from 9 September 2022 (Friday) to 16 September 2022 (Friday), both days inclusive. During such period, no share transfers will be affected. In order to qualify for attending the AGM, all transfer documents, accompanied by the relevant share certificates, must be lodged with the Company's branch share registrar and transfer office in Hong Kong, Tricor Investor Services Limited at 17/F, Far East Finance Centre, 16 Harcourt Road, Hong Kong for registration no later than 4:30 p.m. on 8 September 2022 (Thursday).

RECOMMENDATION

The Directors consider that the granting of the Issue Mandate, the Repurchase Mandate, the re-election of retiring Directors and the proposed amendments to the terms of share options are in the interests of the Company and the Shareholders as a whole. Accordingly, the Directors recommend the Shareholders to vote in favour of all resolutions to be proposed at the AGM and as set out in the AGM Notice.

This appendix serves as an explanatory statement as required under the GEM Listing Rules to provide the requisite information to Shareholders for consideration of the Repurchase Mandate pursuant to Rule 13.08 of the GEM Listing Rules.

1. SHARE CAPITAL

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the issued share capital of the Company comprised 581,442,248 Shares. Subject to the passing of the relevant resolution to approve the Repurchase Mandate and on the basis that no further Shares are allotted and issued or repurchased between the Latest Practicable Date and the date of the AGM, the Company will be allowed to repurchase a maximum of 58,144,224 Shares.

2. SOURCE OF FUNDS

The Directors propose that the repurchase of Shares under the Repurchase Mandate would be financed from the Company's internal resources.

In the repurchase of the Shares, the Company may only apply funds which are legally available for such purposes in accordance with the constitutive documents of the Company, the GEM Listing Rules and the applicable laws and regulations of the Cayman Islands. The Company will not purchase the Shares on the GEM for a consideration other than cash or for settlement otherwise than in accordance with the trading rules of the Stock Exchange from time to time.

3. REASONS FOR SHARE REPURCHASE

Although the Directors have no present intention of exercising the proposed Repurchase Mandate, the Directors believe that the flexibility afforded by the proposed Repurchase Mandate would be beneficial to the Company and the Shareholders. An exercise of the Repurchase Mandate may, depending on market conditions at the time, lead to an enhancement of the net asset value and/or earnings per Share and will only be made when the Directors believe that repurchase of Shares will benefit the Company and Shareholders as a whole.

5. UNDERTAKING

The Directors have undertaken to the Stock Exchange that, so far as the same may be applicable, they will make repurchases pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate in accordance with the GEM Listing Rules and the applicable laws of the Cayman Islands.

6. EFFECT OF THE TAKEOVERS CODE

If as a result of a repurchase of Shares pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate, a Shareholder's proportionate interest in the voting rights of the Company increases, such increase will be treated as an acquisition for the purposes of Rule 32 of the Takeovers Code. As a result, a Shareholder, or a group of Shareholders acting in concert (as defined in the Takeovers Code), depending on the level of increase of the Shareholder's interest, could obtain or consolidate control of the Company and become obliged to make a mandatory offer in accordance with Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code.

Great Walle Investment is ultimately controlled by Mr. Song. As such, each of Nansha Huiming, Huili Jiu Hao Investment, Great Walle Investment and Mr. Song is deemed to be interested in 184,465,046 Shares held by Greatwalle Holding Limited under the SFO.
- According to information available to the Company, 249,090,909 Shares are held by Walle Holding Limited in the capacity of beneficial owner. Walle Holding Limited is wholly-owned by Mr. Song. On the basis that the total number of Shares in issue remain unchanged from the Latest Practicable Date to the date of the AGM, in the event that the Repurchase Mandate is exercised in full, the increase of the attributable shareholding of Greatwalle Holding Limited, Nansha Huiming, Huili Jiu Hao Investment, Great Walle Investment and Walle Holding Limited would give rise to an obligation to make a mandatory offer in accordance with Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code.

However, the Directors have no present intention to exercise the Repurchase Mandate to the extent that will result in a requirement of any of the above Shareholder(s) or any other persons to make a mandatory offer in accordance with Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code or the number of Shares in the hands of the public would fall below the prescribed minimum percentage of 25%. The Directors will exercise the powers conferred by the Repurchase Mandate to repurchase Shares in circumstances, which they deem appropriate for the benefits of the Company and the Shareholders as a whole.

7. DISCLOSURE OF INTERESTS OF DIRECTORS, THEIR CLOSE ASSOCIATES AND CORE CONNECTED PERSONS

As at the Latest Practicable Date, none of the Directors nor, to the best of their respective knowledge and belief and having made all reasonable enquiries, their Close Associates, have any present intention, if the Repurchase Mandate is approved by the Shareholders and is exercised, to sell any Shares to the Company or any of its subsidiaries under the Repurchase Mandate.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, no Core Connected Person of the Company has notified the Company that he/she/it has a present intention to sell any Shares in the event that the Repurchase Mandate is approved by the Shareholders.

8. MATERIAL ADVERSE CHANGE

As compared with the financial position of the Company as at 31 March 2022 (being the date to which the latest audited accounts of the Company have been made up), the Directors consider that there might be a material adverse impact on the working capital and on the gearing position of the Company in the event that the proposed repurchases were to be carried out in full during the proposed repurchase period.

However, the Directors do not propose to exercise the Repurchase Mandate to such extent as would, in the circumstances, have a material adverse effect on the working capital of the Company or the gearing position which in the opinion of the Directors are from time to time appropriate for the Company.

9. SHARE REPURCHASE MADE BY THE COMPANY

The Company had not purchased any of the Shares (whether on GEM or otherwise) during the six months ended on the Latest Practicable Date.

APPENDIX II DETAILS OF THE RETIRING DIRECTORS PROPOSED TO BE RE-ELECTED AND APPOINTED AT THE AGM

The following are the particulars of the retiring Directors proposed to be re-elected and appointed at the AGM:

(A) RE-ELECTION OF RETIRING DIRECTORS

Mr. Xiaoming (宋曉明)

Mr. Song Xiaoming (“**Mr. Song**”), aged 48, was appointed as an executive Director on 6 August 2019. He is also the chairman of the Board and controlling shareholder of the Company and the chairman of Nomination Committee of the Company. Mr. Song is the founder of Shenzhen Great Walle Capital Management Co., Ltd.* (深圳長城匯理資產管理有限公司), a company incorporated in May 2013 and principally engaged in the provision of asset management service. In 2015 it became a subsidiary of Shenzhen Great Walle Investment Corp., Ltd. * (深圳長城匯理投資股份有限公司) (“**Great Walle Investment**”), one of the controlling shareholders of the Company. Since June 2015, Mr. Song has become the director of Walle Holding Limited, one of the controlling shareholders of the Company. He has been the chief executive officer of Shenzhen Great Walle Capital Management Co., Ltd. since May 2013 and the president of Great Walle Investment since July 2015. Mr. Song graduated from Sun Yat-sen University with a bachelor degree in economics in June 1997 and obtained an executive master of business administration degree from Tsinghua University, the PRC in January 2014. In June 2021, he obtained an executive master of business administration degree from Singapore Management University.

Mr. Song is the elder brother of Ms. Song Shiqing, an executive Director.

Mr. Song has entered into a service agreement with the Company as an executive Director for a fixed term of three years commencing on 6 August 2019, he waived his director’s remuneration since 23 June 2021.

Mr. Zhao Jinsong (趙勁松)

Mr. Zhao Jinsong (“**Mr. Zhao**”), aged 46, was appointed as an independent non-executive Director on 12 July 2018.
