3. Please insert the name and address of the proxy. If no name is inserted, the Chairman of the Meeting will act as your proxy. A shareholder of the Company (the “Member”) may appoint one (or, if the Member holds two or more Shares, more than one) proxy of the Member’s own choice to attend the meeting and vote for the Member. **The proxy need not be a Member but must attend the EGM in person to represent you.** If more than one proxy is appointed, the original form of proxy may be photocopied for use.

5. If you wish to vote part of your Shares for and part of your Shares against the relevant resolution in the event that a poll is called, please insert the number of Shares in the relevant box.
6. This form of proxy must be signed by you or your attorney duly authorised in writing or, in the case of a corporation, must be either executed under its common seal or under the hand of its legal representative, director(s) or duly authorised attorney(s) to do it.
7. In the case of joint shareholders, the signature of any one shareholder will be sufficient but the names of all the joint shareholders should be stated.
8. Where there are joint holders of any Share, any one of such joint holders may vote at the EGM, either in person or by proxy, in respect of such Share as if he/she were solely entitled thereto, but if more than one of such joint holders are present at the EGM in person or by proxy, the vote of the senior holder who tenders a vote, shall be accepted to the exclusion of the votes of the other joint holders, and for this purpose, seniority shall be determined by the order in which the names stand in the register of members of the Company in respect of the joint holding.
9. In order to be valid, this form of proxy must be completed, signed and deposited at the Company’s Hong Kong share registrar and transfer office, Union Registrars Limited (the “**Hong Kong Share Registrar**”) at Suites 3301-04, 33/F., Two Chinachem Exchange Square, 338 King’s Road, North Point, Hong Kong together with a power of attorney or other authority, if any, under which it is signed (or a certified copy thereof), not later than 72 hours before the time appointed for holding the EGM or the adjournment thereof. Completion and return of the form of proxy shall not preclude Members from subsequently attending and voting in person at the EGM or the adjournment thereof should they so wish, and in such event, the form of proxy shall be deemed to have been revoked.
10. **Any alteration made to this form of proxy must be initialed by the person who signs it.**
11. The Company reserves its right to treat any form of proxy which has been incorrectly completed in some manner as valid if such incorrectness is considered by the Company, at its absolute discretion, not material.
12. A Member or his/her/its proxy should produce proof of identity when attending the EGM. If a corporate Member appoints its representative to attend the EGM, such representative should produce proof of identity and a copy of the resolution of the board of directors or other governing body of that Member appointing such representative to attend the EGM.

**PERSONAL INFORMATION COLLECTION STATEMENT**

- (i) “Personal Data” in these statements has the same meaning as “personal data” in the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance, Chapter 486 of the Laws of Hong Kong (the “PDPO”) and the Singapore Personal Data Protection Act 2012.
- (ii) Your supply of Personal Data to the Company is on a voluntary basis and is used for processing your instructions and/or requests as stated in this form of proxy.
- (iii) By submitting an instrument appointing a proxy(ies) and/or representative(s) to attend, speak and vote at the EGM and/or any adjournment thereof, a member of the Company (a) consents to the collection, use and disclosure of the member’s Personal Data by the Company (or its agents) for the purpose of processing and administration by the Company (or its agents) of proxies and representatives appointed for the EGM (including any adjournment thereof) and preparation and compilation of the attendance lists, minutes and other documents relating to the EGM (including any adjournment thereof), and in order for the Company (or its agents) to comply with any applicable laws, listing rules, regulations and/or guidelines (collectively, the “Purposes”); (b) warrants that where the member discloses the Personal Data of the member’s proxy(ies) and/or representative(s) to the Company (or its agents), the member has obtained the prior consent of such proxy(ies) and/or representative(s) for the collection, use and disclosure by the Company (or its agents) of the Personal Data of such proxy(ies) and/or representative(s) for the Purposes; and (c) agrees that the member will indemnify the Company in respect of any penalties, liabilities, claims, demands, losses and damages as a result of the member’s breach of warranty.
