This announcement is made by Oriental Payment Group Holdings Limited (the “**Company**”, together with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”) pursuant to Rule 17.10 of the Rules (the “**GEM Listing Rules**”) Governing the Listing of Securities on GEM of The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the “**Stock Exchange**”) and the Inside Information Provisions under Part XIVA of the Securities and Futures Ordinance (Cap. 571 of the Laws of Hong Kong).

The board (the “**Board**”) of directors (“**Director(s)**”) of the Company hereby informs the shareholders (the “**Shareholder(s)**”) and potential investors of the Company that based on the preliminary assessment of the unaudited consolidated management accounts of the Group for the year ended 31 March 2025 (the “**FY2024/25**”) and other information currently available to the Board, the Group is expected to record a loss attributable to equity owners of the Company of approximately HK\$34.2 million for FY2024/25, as compared with to a loss attributable to equity owners of the Company of approximately HK\$37.2 million for the year ended 31 March 2024, representing a decrease in loss attributable to equity owners of the Company of approximately 7.9%. The loss attributable to equity owners of the Company for FY2024/25 was mainly due to the high-profile kidnapping case in Thailand during 2025 Lunar New Year. In response to safety concerns, Chinese tourist bookings to Thailand declined, which highlighted the volatility of tourism-dependent markets. This downturn led to a decrease in e-payment transaction volumes for the Group in early 2025, despite its strong performance earlier in FY2024/25.

The Company is still in the course of preparing and finalising the consolidated financial statements of the Group for the FY2024/25. The information contained in this announcement is only a preliminary assessment by the Company based on the unaudited consolidated management accounts of the Group for the FY2024/25 and other information currently available to the Board, which has not been audited or agreed by the independent auditor or the audit committee of the Board and is subject to possible adjustments upon their further review. The actual financial results for the FY2024/25 may be different from the information disclosed in this announcement. The Group’s annual results announcement for the year ended 31 March 2025 is expected to be published by the Company on 26 June 2025.

Shareholders and potential investors of the Company are advised to exercise caution when dealing in the shares of the Company.
