**DISCLOSEABLE TRANSACTION
IN RELATION TO THE TENANCY AGREEMENT**

On 6 July 2026, the Tenant and the Landlord entered into the Tenancy Agreement in respect of the Premises for a fixed term of three years from 6 July 2026 to 5 July 2029 (both days inclusive) with an option to renew for another three years.

In accordance with HKFRS 16 “Leases”, the Company recognises the value of the right-of-use assets on its consolidated statement of financial position in connection with the lease of the Premises under the Tenancy Agreement. Accordingly, the transaction under the Tenancy Agreement is regarded as an acquisition of right-of-use asset by the Group.

As one or more of the applicable percentage ratios (as defined in the GEM Listing Rules) in respect of the transaction contemplated under the Tenancy Agreement based on the value of the right-of-use of the Premises recognised by the Group exceeds 5% but all of them are less than 25%, the transaction contemplated under the Tenancy Agreement constitutes a discloseable transaction and is subject to the reporting and announcement requirements under Chapter 19 of the GEM Listing Rules.

THE TENANCY AGREEMENT

Date : 6 July 2026

Parties : (i) New Excellent Development Limited as the landlord; and
(ii) Katachi VIII International Limited (a subsidiary of the Company) as tenant.

The Landlord, who has entered into an operating lease with the Tenant, is controlled by Nan Fung Group, a well-respected and widely recognized real estate developer. However, due to privacy considerations, the Landlord is unwilling to disclose the identities of the ultimate beneficial owners to the Company. As a result, the Company is unable to ascertain the identities of these individuals.

To the best of the Directors' knowledge, information and belief, having made all reasonable enquiries, the Landlord and its ultimate beneficial owner are Independent Third Parties.

Premises : Shop A03A and A05 on the Ground Floor of Ma On Shan Centre, No. 1 On Chun Street, Shatin, New Territories, Hong Kong

Term : A fixed term of 3 years from 6 July 2026 to 5 July 2029 (both days inclusive), with an option granted to the Tenant to renew the lease for another three years at the then prevailing market rent but in any event not be less than HK\$50,000 per month but not more than HK\$60,000 per month (the “**Option to Renew**”).

Rent : **Basic Rent**

For the period from 6 July 2026 to 5 October 2026: Nil, being the rent-free period; and

For the period from 6 October 2026 to 5 July 2029: HK\$50,000 per month.

Additional Turnover Rent

10% of the monthly turnover of the Tenant's business at the Premises exceeding the Monthly Basic Rent.

The rent is exclusive of government rent, rates, management fees and all other Tenant's expenses and outgoings, and is payable by the Tenant to the Landlord in advance before the 1st day of each month.

The rent was determined by the parties after arm's length negotiations with reference to the prevailing market rent for similar comparable properties in the vicinity of the Premises. The rental payments will be settled out of the internal resources of the Group.

Consideration and Right-of-use assets

The total aggregate value of consideration payable under the Tenancy Agreement will not be more than HK\$3,810,000, being the maximum rental payments in aggregate for the term of 6 years (to the extent that Option to Renew is exercised by the Company).

In accordance with HKFRS 16 “Leases”, the Company recognises the value of the right-of-use assets on its consolidated statement of financial position in connection with the lease of the Premises under the Tenancy Agreement. Accordingly, the lease transaction under the Tenancy Agreement is regarded as an acquisition of right-of-use asset by the Group.

Subject to audit, the value of the right-of-use asset to be recognised by the Company under the Tenancy Agreement is estimated to be approximately HK\$3,514,000, being the present value of aggregate rent payable under the Tenancy Agreement for the term of six years (to the extent that Option to Renew is exercised by the Company), under the Tenancy Agreement in accordance with HKFRS 16.

INFORMATION OF THE PARTIES

The Landlord

To the best of the knowledge, information and belief of the Company having made all reasonable enquiries, (i) the Landlord is a company incorporated in the Hong Kong with limited liability; (ii) the principal business activity of the Landlord is investment in properties; and (iii) based on information available to the Company, as at the date of this announcement, the immediate controlling shareholder of the Landlord is Digital Ace Limited, a company incorporated in the British Virgin Islands with limited liability.

For the purpose of Rule 14.58(3) of the GEM Listing Rules, the Company has make an enquiry with the Landlord regarding its ultimate beneficial owners and the Landlord has refused to provide due to privacy reasons. Pursuant to the listed issuer regulation newsletter issued by the Stock Exchange in December 2020, in some situations, disclosure of the counterparty itself or its intermediate owner could provide sufficient information. This may include, among others, where the company receives or provides services in its ordinary and usual course of business, the customer or service provider, such as the contractor providing construction service, or the landlord in an operating lease.

To safeguard the interest of the Company and its shareholders as a whole, the Company has made an enquiry to the Landlord whether any of the connected persons (as defined in the GEM Listing Rules) of the Company or their respective associates is one of the ultimate beneficial owners of the Landlord, and the Landlord has confirmed that none of the connected persons of the Company or their respective associates is one of the ultimate beneficial owners of the Landlord.

The Tenant and the Group

The Tenant is a company incorporated in Hong Kong with limited liability and a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company. It was incorporated on 12 August 2021 for engaging in the principal business of operation of a restaurant in Hong Kong.

The Group is a chained bar and restaurant group under the brands “Bar Pacific”, “Katachi”, “Moon Ocean” and “Pacific” with locations scattered over Hong Kong and the People’s Republic of China. It is also engaged in property investment in Hong Kong.

REASONS FOR AND BENEFITS OF ENTERING INTO THE TENANCY AGREEMENT

The Directors consider that the Premises is located at a strategic location for the Group’s expansion in its bar and restaurant operations in Hong Kong. The terms of the Tenancy Agreement were arrived at after arm’s length negotiations and the rent was determined with reference to the prevailing market rental of similar comparable properties in the vicinity of the Premises. Based on the above, the Board is of the view that the terms of the Tenancy Agreement are fair and reasonable, on normal commercial terms and in the interests of the Company and its shareholders as a whole.

IMPLICATIONS UNDER THE GEM LISTING RULES

As one or more of the applicable percentage ratios (as defined in the GEM Listing Rules) in respect of the transaction contemplated under the Tenancy Agreement based on the value of the right-of-use of the Premises recognised by the Group exceeds 5% but all of them are less than 25%, the transaction contemplated under the Tenancy Agreement constitutes a discloseable transaction and is subject to the reporting and announcement requirements under Chapter 19 of the GEM Listing Rules.
