Your proxy will also be entitled to vote at his/her discretion on any resolution properly put to the 2026 AGM other than those referred to in the Notice. If you wish to vote part of your Shares for and part of your Shares against the relevant resolution in the poll, please insert the number of Shares in the relevant box.
- The form of proxy must be signed by the appointor or his attorney duly authorised in writing or, if such appointor is a corporation, must be either under its common seal or under the hand of an officer, attorney or other person authorised to sign on that behalf.
- In the case of joint shareholders, the signature of any one shareholder will be sufficient but the names of all the joint shareholders should be stated.
- Where there are joint holders of any Share, any one of such joint holders may vote at the 2026 AGM, either personally or by proxy, in respect of such Share as if he/she were solely entitled thereto, but if more than one of such joint holders are present at the 2026 AGM personally or by proxy, that one of such joint holders so present whose name stands first in the register of members of the Company in respect of the joint holding shall alone be entitled to vote in respect thereof.
- In order to be valid, this form of proxy must be completed, signed and deposited at the Company’s Hong Kong branch share registrar and transfer office, Tricor Investor Services Limited (“Tricor”) together with a power of attorney or other authority, if any, under which it is signed (or a certified copy thereof), not later than 48 hours before the time appointed for holding the 2026 AGM or the adjournment thereof. Tricor’s present address is 17/F, Far East Finance Centre, 16 Harcourt Road, Admiralty, Hong Kong. Completion and return of the form of proxy shall not preclude the Members from subsequently attending in person and voting at the 2026 AGM or the adjournment thereof, should they so wish, and in such event, the form of proxy shall be deemed to have been revoked.
- Any alteration made to this form of proxy must be initialled by the person who signs it.
- The Company reserves its right to treat any form of proxy which has been incorrectly completed in some manner as valid if such incorrectness is considered by the Company, at its absolute discretion, not material.
- A Member or his/her/its proxy should produce proof of identity when attending the 2026 AGM. If a corporate Member appoints its representative to attend the 2026 AGM, such representative should produce proof of identity and a copy of the resolution of the board of directors or other governing body of that Member appointing such representative to attend the 2026 AGM.
