Whilst the cargo businesses of both carriers remain normal, their freighter services remain mostly unaffected.

Keeping abreast of the current situation, the Board has taken necessary actions to reduce scheduled capacity, tighten spending and exercise a prudent cash conservation.

At this stage, conditions are extremely volatile. The Board considers it too early to ascertain the overall impact on the financial position of the Company.

Shareholders of the Company and investors should exercise caution when dealing the shares of the Company.
