- (5) Refund cheques will be issued without interest in respect of wholly or partially unsuccessful applications and also in respect of successful applications in the event that the Offer Price is less than the maximum Offer Price per Share paid on application. Applicants for 100,000 Hong Kong Offer Shares or more and who have indicated in their Application Forms that they wish to collect refund cheques and share certificates (as relevant) personally from the Hong Kong Share Registrar may collect refund cheques (where applicable) and share certificates (where applicable) from the Hong Kong Share Registrar from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on Thursday, March 15, 2007 or any other date notified by the Company in the newspapers as the date of despatch of share certificates/refund cheques. Individual applicants who opt for personal collection must not authorise any other person to make their collection on their behalf. Corporate applicants that opt for personal collection must attend by their authorised representatives, each bearing a letter of authorisation from such corporation stamped with the corporation's chop. Both individuals and authorised representatives (if applicable) must produce, at the time of collection, evidence of identity acceptable to the Hong Kong Share Registrar. Uncollected share certificates and refund cheques will be despatched by ordinary post at the applicants' own risk to the addresses specified in the relevant Application Form promptly thereafter.
