**MONTHLY ANNOUNCEMENT**

References are made to the circular (the “**Circular**”) of the Company dated 30 August 2019 in relation to mandate for the disposal of shares of China SCE Group Holdings Limited and the monthly announcement of the Company dated 5 December 2019. Capitalised terms used herein shall have the same meanings as those defined in the Circular unless the context requires otherwise.

At the SGM, the Shareholders approved the Disposal and the Mandate for the Disposal, authorizing the Directors to dispose all or in part(s) of the 6,800,000 CSCE Shares held by the Group during the Mandate Period from the date of passing the resolution on 16 September 2019.

As at 30 November 2019, the Group owned a total of 6,613,000 CSCE Shares. During the period from 1 December 2019 to 31 December 2019, the Group disposed an aggregate of 300,000 CSCE Shares with a gain of approximately HK\$729,000, which is calculated based on the selling price (excluding the transaction costs) less the acquisition cost, and the selling price per CSCE Share (excluding the transaction costs) was approximately HK\$4.06. As at 31 December 2019, the Group still owns a total of 6,313,000 CSCE Shares.
