VOLUNTARY ANNOUNCEMENT AUSTRALIA TO WELCOME STUDENT VISA HOLDERS FROM 1 DECEMBER 2021 ENCOURAGES GROUP'S BUSINESS

This announcement is made by Top Education Group Ltd (the “**Company**” or “**TOP**”, together with its subsidiary, the “**Group**”) on a voluntary basis.

On 22 November 2021, Australian Government announced that from 1 December 2021, fully vaccinated skilled and student visa holders, working holiday maker and other eligible visa holders can come to Australia without needing to apply for a travel exemption. Travellers would need to be fully vaccinated with Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA) approved or recognised vaccines, currently including but not limited to AstraZeneca Vaxzevria, AstraZeneca Covishield, Pfizer/Biontech Comirnaty, Sinovac Coronavac and Sinopharm BBIBP-CorV (for 18-60 year olds), and present a negative COVID-19 Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) test taken within three days of departure. The New South Wales Government has also announced earlier that the international students who are recognised as fully vaccinated will not be required to quarantine upon arrival. It is expected by the Australian Government that 200,000 or more eligible visa holders will arrive in the coming months.

The main business of the Group includes providing high quality education services to international students from various countries/regions. The Company believes that the further ease of Australia’s international border will strongly encourage the Group’s business along with the boost to Australia’s economic recovery as well as to the education industry.
