The Directors consider that the Second Disposal represented a good opportunity to realise a reasonable gain in Future Empire's investment in IDG Energy and obtain additional cash flow. Given that the Second Disposal is made on the Stock Exchange at the prevailing market prices, the Directors (including the independent non-executive Directors) consider that the Second Disposal is on normal commercial terms, fair and reasonable, and in the interests of the Company and its shareholders as a whole.
