- A member entitled to attend and vote at the meeting may appoint a proxy or, if holding two or more ordinary shares, more than one proxy to attend, and speak and vote at, the meeting or any adjournment thereof on his behalf. If a member appoints more than one proxy, he must specify the number of ordinary shares each proxy is appointed to represent. A proxy need not be a member of the Company. However, given the special arrangements adopted by the Company as set out in the section headed “Special Arrangements for the Annual General Meeting” of the Company’s circular dated 1 April 2022, if a member (other than those who are required to attend the AGM physically to form a quorate meeting) wishes to vote on any resolution at the Principal Meeting Venue of the AGM, he/she/it shall complete the proxy form and appoint the Chairman of the Meeting as his/her/its proxy to exercise his/her/its right to vote at the Principal Meeting Venue of the AGM in accordance with his/her/its instructions.

- Please indicate with a “✓” in the appropriate space beside each of the resolutions showing how you wish your proxy to vote. In the absence of any such indication, you will be deemed to have authorised your proxy to vote or to abstain from voting at his discretion.
- Where there are joint registered holders of any ordinary share, any one of such persons may vote at any meeting, either personally or by proxy, in respect of such ordinary share as if he were solely entitled thereto; but if more than one of such joint holders be present at any meeting personally or by proxy, that one of the said persons so present whose name stands first on the register of members of the Company in respect of such ordinary share(s) shall alone be entitled to vote in respect thereof.
- This form of proxy must be signed by the appointer, or his attorney duly authorised in writing, or if the appointer is a corporation, either under its common seal or under the hand of an officer or attorney duly authorised in writing.

- Registered members are requested to provide a valid email address of his or her proxy (except for appointment of “the Chairman of the Meeting” as proxy) in order for the proxy to receive the username and password from the Company’s share registrar, Tricor Standard Limited, to participate and vote online at the AGM via the e-Meeting System.
