The board ("Board") of directors ("Directors") of the Company wishes to inform the shareholders of the Company ("Shareholders") and potential investors that based on the preliminary review and analysis of the unaudited consolidated management accounts of the Group currently available, the Group is expected to record a profit in the range of approximately HK\$38 million to HK\$53 million for the six months ended 30 June 2022 ("1H 2022"), as compared to the profit of approximately HK\$8.1 million for the six months ended 30 June 2021 ("1H 2021").

The Board considers that the increase in profit recorded in 1H 2022 was primarily attributable to the recognition of the gain on disposal of the holding company of the building in Fanling completed in January 2022, which was partially offset by (i) the fair value loss on held-fortrading investments recorded during 1H 2022 of approximately HK\$2.2 million (1H 2021: fair value loss of approximately HK\$0.8 million) and (ii) the fair value loss of investment properties recorded during 1H 2022 of approximately HK\$4.5 million (1H 2021: fair value gain of approximately HK\$36.0 million).

The Company is still in the process of finalising the consolidated results of the Group for 1H 2022, especially the amount of the impairment loss (if any) on financial assets and contract assets and therefore, the expected profit for 1H 2022 to be recorded by the Group may be subject to further change. The information contained in this announcement is only a preliminary assessment by the management of the Company based on the unaudited consolidated management accounts of the Group currently available and have not been audited or reviewed by the auditors of the Company.
