2. PROPOSED SHARE CONSOLIDATION

The Board proposes that every ten (10) Existing Shares in the issued and unissued share capital of the Company be consolidated into one (1) Consolidated Share.

Effects of the Share Consolidation

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the authorised share capital of the Company is HK\$2,500,000,000 divided into 250,000,000,000 Shares of par value of HK\$0.01 each, and there are 8,611,690,000 Existing Shares in issue which are fully paid or credited as fully paid. Assuming no further Shares will be issued from the Latest Practicable Date up to the date of the SGM, upon the Share Consolidation becoming effective, there will be 861,169,000 Consolidated Shares in issue which are fully paid or credited as fully paid. The authorised share capital of the Company will remain at HK\$2,500,000,000 but will be divided into 25,000,000,000 Consolidated Shares of HK\$0.1 each.

Upon the Share Consolidation becoming effective, the Consolidated Shares shall rank *pari passu* in all respects with each other.

Other than the expenses to be incurred in relation to the Share Consolidation, the implementation of the Share Consolidation will not alter the underlying assets, business operations, management or financial position of the Company or the proportionate interests or rights of the Shareholders. 861,169,000 Consolidated Shares in issue which are fully paid or credited as fully paid. The authorised share capital of the Company will remain at HK\$2,500,000,000 but will be divided into 25,000,000,000 Consolidated Shares of HK\$0.1 each.

Pursuant to Rule 13.64 of the Listing Rules, where the market price of the securities of an issuer approaches the extremities of HK\$0.01 or HK\$9,995.00, the issuer may be required either to change the trading method or to proceed with a consolidation or splitting of its securities. The “Guide on Trading Arrangements for Selected Types of Corporate Actions” issued by the Hong Kong Exchanges and Clearing Limited on 28 November 2008 and updated on 1 October 2020 (the “Guide”) has further stated that market price of the shares at a level less than HK\$0.1 will be considered as trading at extremity as referred to under Rule 13.64 of the Listing Rules. It has also stated in the Guide that taking into account the minimum transaction costs for a securities trade, the expected board lot value should be greater than HK\$2,000.

Since October 2019, the share price of the Company has been constantly below HK\$0.1 each and the existing board lot value has been less than HK\$2,000. The proposed Share Consolidation will increase the nominal value of the Shares and would bring a corresponding upward adjustment in the expected value per board lot. Based on the closing price of HK\$0.027 per Existing Share (equivalent to the theoretical closing price of HK\$0.27 per Consolidated Share) as at the date of the Announcement, (i) the value per board lot of 10,000 Existing Shares is HK\$270; and (ii) the value per board lot of 10,000 Consolidated Shares would be HK\$2,700 on the assumption that the Share Consolidation becomes effective. Therefore, the Board considers that the Share Consolidation in the ratio of ten (10) Existing Shares in the issued and unissued share capital to be consolidated into one (1) Consolidated Share shall be the maximum ratio accepted by the company of which will enable the Company (i) to comply with the trading requirements under the Listing Rules and (ii) maintain each board lot size of the Consolidated Shares. The Board considers the Share Consolidation in the said ratio is fair and reasonable.
