PROPOSALS FOR GENERAL MANDATES TO ISSUE SHARES AND TO REPURCHASE SHARES, RE-ELECTION OF DIRECTORS AND DECLARATION OF FINAL DIVIDEND

INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this circular is to provide you with information in respect of the resolutions to be proposed to seek approval of the Shareholders in respect of, among other matters, (i) the granting to the Directors the Issue Mandate and the Repurchase Mandate; (ii) the re-election of Directors; and (iii) the declaration of final dividend.

GENERAL MANDATES

Pursuant to the written resolutions of the then Shareholders passed on 27 April 2022, the Directors were granted by the then Shareholders (i) a general unconditional mandate to allot, issue and deal in Shares not exceeding 20% of the aggregate number of Shares in issue immediately following the completion of the Capitalisation Issue and the Global Offering; (ii) a general unconditional mandate to repurchase Shares up to 10% of the aggregate number of

Shares in issue immediately following the completion of the Capitalisation Issue and the Global Offering; and (iii) to extend the general mandate mentioned in (i) above by the addition of an amount representing the aggregate number of Shares repurchased by the Company pursuant to the mandate to repurchase Shares referred to (ii) above.

The above general mandates will continue in force until (i) the conclusion of the AGM; or (ii) the date by which the AGM is required by the Articles or the Companies Act or any applicable law(s); or (iii) the revocation or variation by ordinary resolution of the Shareholders in general meeting, whichever occurs first. The Directors would therefore like to seek your approval by way of ordinary resolutions to be proposed at the AGM to approve the Issue Mandate and the Repurchase Mandate. The Directors wish to state that they have no immediate plan to issue any Shares or repurchase any Shares pursuant thereto. Please refer to resolutions number 5 to 6 set out in the notice of AGM on pages 15 to 18 of this circular for details of the proposed Issue Mandate and Repurchase Mandate.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the number of issued Shares of the Company was 451,770,000 Shares, assuming that no further Shares are to be issued or repurchased prior to the AGM, the Issue Mandate will grant to the Directors an authority to issue up to 90,354,000 Shares.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

An explanatory statement containing all relevant information relating to the proposed Repurchase Mandate is set out in the Appendix I to this circular. The explanatory statement is to provide you with information reasonably necessary to enable you to make an informed decision on whether to vote for or against the resolution to grant to the Directors the Repurchase Mandate at the AGM.

RE-ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The Board currently consists of six Directors, namely Mr. Wu Yushu, Ms. Wang Lifang, Mr. Fu Haitao, Ms. Wang Danzhou, Ms. Du Yilin and Mr. Wei Bin.

In accordance with Article 108(a) of the Articles, at each annual general meeting one-third of the Directors for the time being, or, if their number is not three or a multiple of three, then the number nearest to but not less than one-third, shall retire from office by rotation provided that every Director (including those appointed for a specific term) shall be subject to retirement at an annual general meeting by rotation at least once every three years. Accordingly, Mr. Wu Yushu and Mr. Fu Haitao will retire by rotation at the AGM and, being eligible, offer themselves for re-election.

The Nomination Committee has reviewed and considered each retiring Directors' respective experience, skills and knowledge, and recommended to the Board that the re-election of all retiring Directors be proposed for Shareholders' approval at the Annual General Meeting.

Details of the above-mentioned Directors proposed to be re-elected at the AGM are set out in Appendix II to this circular, which indicates how the Directors to be elected contribute to the diversity of the Board.

DECLARATION OF FINAL DIVIDEND

As stated in the announcement of the Company dated 29 March 2023 relating to, among others, the consolidated annual results of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2022, the Board has recommended the payment of a final dividend of HK3.98 cents per Share for the year ended 31 December 2022 (the "**Proposed Final Dividend**") to Shareholders whose names appear on the register of members of the Company at the close of business on Wednesday, 28 June 2023. Subject to the approval of Shareholders at the AGM, it is expected that the final dividend will be payable on or around Tuesday, 25 July 2023.

The Board confirms that with respect to the dividend, the Company shall be able to pay its debts as they fall due in the ordinary course of business immediately following the date on which the dividend is proposed to be paid.

For determining the entitlement to the Proposed Final Dividend (subject to the approval by Shareholders at the AGM) for the year ended 31 December 2022, the register of members of the Company will be closed from Monday, 26 June 2023 to Wednesday, 28 June 2023, both days inclusive, during which period, no transfer of shares will be registered. In order to be qualified for the Proposed Final Dividend, all transfer documents accompanied by the relevant share certificates must be lodged with the Company's branch share registrar in Hong Kong, Boardroom Share Registrars (HK) Limited at 2103B, 21/F, 148 Electric Road, North Point, Hong Kong for registration not later than 4:30 p.m. on Friday, 23 June 2023.

ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

Set out on pages 15 to 18 of this circular is a notice convening the AGM to consider and, if appropriate, to approve, among others, the ordinary resolutions relating to the proposals for the granting of the Issue Mandate and the Repurchase Mandate and re-election of Directors.

A form of proxy for use at the AGM is enclosed herewith. If you are not able to attend and/or vote at the AGM in person, you are requested to complete the form of proxy and return it to the Company's branch share registrar and transfer office in Hong Kong, Boardroom Share Registrars (HK) Limited at Room 2103B, 21/F, 148 Electric Road, North Point, Hong Kong as soon as possible and in any event not less than 48 hours before the time of the AGM or any adjournment thereof. Completion and return of the form of proxy shall not preclude you from attending and voting in person at the AGM or any adjournment thereof should you so wish.

Pursuant to Rule 13.39(4) of the Listing Rules and Article 72 of the Articles of Association, any vote of Shareholders at a general meeting must be taken by poll except where the chairman of the general meeting, in good faith, decides to allow a resolution which relates purely to procedural or administrative matter to be voted by a show of hands. 1. LISTING RULES RELATING TO THE REPURCHASE OF SHARES

The Listing Rules permit companies whose primary listings are on the Stock Exchange to repurchase their shares on the Stock Exchange subject to certain restrictions.

2. SHARE CAPITAL

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the issued share capital of the Company comprised 451,770,000 Shares. Subject to the passing of the resolution for repurchase of Shares and on the basis that no further new Shares will be issued or repurchased prior to the AGM, the Company would be allowed under the Repurchase Mandate to repurchase a maximum of 45,177,000 Shares, representing 10% of the existing issued Shares as at the Latest Practicable Date.

3. REASONS FOR REPURCHASES OF SHARES

The Directors believe that the Repurchase Mandate is in the interests of the Company and the Shareholders. Such repurchases may, depending on market conditions and funding arrangements at the time, lead to an enhancement of the net assets of the Company and/or its earnings per share and will only be made when the Directors believe that such a repurchase will benefit the Company and the Shareholders.

4. FUNDING OF REPURCHASES OF SHARES

Any repurchase of securities of the Company would be funded entirely from the cash flow or working capital facilities available to the Company, and will, in any event be made out of funds legally available for the purpose in accordance with the Articles, the applicable laws of the Cayman Islands and the Listing Rules. Prior to founding Guangzhou Sinohealth Information Co., Ltd (廣州中康資訊股份 有限公司), the principal operating subsidiary of the Group, in December 2007, from July 1997 to December 2007, Mr. Wu served as the general manager of information center (信息中心總 經理) of NMPA Southern Medicine Economic Research Institute (國家藥品監督管理局南方醫 藥經濟研究所) ("SMERI"). During his service period in SMERI, he was also designated as the general manager of the operating company of Medical and Pharmaceutical Economic Newspaper (醫藥經濟報) hosted by SMERI.
