- In case of joint holders, the vote of the senior who tenders a vote, whether in person or by proxy, will be accepted to the exclusion of votes of the other joint holder(s) and for this purpose seniority will be determined by the order in which the names of the holders stand in the Register of Members of the Company.
- In order to be valid, this form of proxy and any authority under which it is executed or a copy of the authority certified notarially, must be deposited at the Company’s share registrar, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, at 17M Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen’s Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong not less than 48 hours (excluding any part of a day that is a public holiday) before the time appointed for the meeting or the adjourned meeting (as the case may be). Accordingly, the form of proxy must be delivered to the Company’s share registrar not later than 10:00 a.m. on Monday, 5 June 2023.
- Deposit of the form of proxy will not preclude you from attending and voting in person at the AGM if you so wish and in such event, the form of proxy shall be deemed to be revoked.
