Qiyue Hongtai plans to carry out renovation to the project to create a smart and garden-like nursing home that integrates medical and geriatric care, so as to enhance the geriatric and medical services of the nursing home in Luoxi, which will be renamed as Luoxi Nursing Home (Integrated Medical and Geriatric Care). The Group believes that winning the tender for the Luoxi Nursing Home project will bring positive and favourable impact on the Group's performance in the near future.

Changzhou Luoxi Nursing Home is located at 997 Zhengtai Road, Luoxi, Xinbei District, Changzhou, Jiangsu Province, the construction of which was financed by the Luoxi Government in 2009. Divided into three buildings in the south, central and north, the project covers a total area of 15,000 sq.m., with a construction area of 4,800 sq.m., a landscaping area of approximately 5,000 sq.m., and a total of 152 beds.
