In case of joint holders, the vote of the senior who tenders a vote, whether in person or by proxy, will be accepted to the exclusion of votes of the other joint holder(s) and for this purpose seniority will be determined by the order in which the names stand in the register of members of the Company.

In order to be valid, the form of proxy and, if requested by the Board, the power of attorney or other authority (if any) under which it is signed or a notarially certified copy of that power or authority, must be deposited at the Company’s share registrar in Hong Kong, Tricor Investor Services Limited, at 17/F, Far East Finance Centre, 16 Harcourt Road, Hong Kong not less than 48 hours before the time appointed for the holding of the AGM (i.e. not later than 9:30 a.m. on Saturday, 4 May 2024) or any adjournment thereof.
8. Completion and delivery of the form of proxy will not preclude you from attending and voting at the AGM if you so wish.
9. References to time and dates in this form of proxy are to Hong Kong time and dates.
