8. All resolutions set out in the Notice of AGM will be voted by poll at the AGM. On a poll, every shareholder present in person or by proxy or (being a corporation) which is represented by proxy shall have one vote for every share held by him/her.

9. Completion and delivery of this proxy form will not preclude you from attending and voting at the AGM if you so wish.

10. One souvenir will be given to each person present in person (no matter how many shares he or she represents or as the proxy for other shareholders).
