Failure to do so will entitle your proxy to cast his votes at his discretion. Your proxy will also be entitled to vote at his discretion on any amendment to the resolutions referred to in the notice convening the meeting, which have been properly put to the meeting.
- 5. This form of proxy must be signed by you or your attorney duly authorised in writing or, in the case of a corporation, must be signed under the hand of an officer duly authorised on that behalf together with a company chop.
- 6. In the case of joint holders, the vote of the senior who tenders a vote, whether in person or by proxy, will be accepted to the exclusion of the votes of the other joint holder(s), and for this purpose, seniority will be determined by the order in which the names stand in the register of members of the Company.
- 7. To be valid, this form of proxy, together with any power of attorney of other authority (if any) under which it is signed or a notarially certified copy of such power of authority must be deposited at the branch share registrar and transfer office of the Company in Hong Kong, Tricor Tengis Limited, at 17/F, Far East Finance Centre, 16 Harcourt Road, Hong Kong not less than 48 hours before the time appointed for the holding of the meeting (i.e. no later than Tuesday, 4 June 2024 at 3:30 p.m. (Hong Kong time)) or the adjourned meeting (as the case may be).
- 8. Completion and delivery of the form of proxy will not preclude you from attending and voting at the meeting if you so wish. In such event, this form of proxy shall be deemed to be revoked.
- 9. The register of members of the Company will be closed from Monday, 3 June 2024 to Thursday, 6 June 2024, both dates inclusive, during which period no transfer of shares of the Company can be registered. In order to qualify for attending the Annual General Meeting, all properly completed transfer forms accompanied by the relevant share certificates must be lodged with the branch share registrar and transfer office of the Company in Hong Kong, Tricor Tengis Limited, at 17/F, Far East Finance Centre, 16 Harcourt Road, Hong Kong no later than 4:30 p.m. on Friday, 31 May 2024 (Hong Kong time).

PERSONAL INFORMATION COLLECTION STATEMENT
