Attention: Before you appoint persons as your proxy to attend the AGM, please read the circular of the Company dated May 20, 2024.

1. Please insert your full name(s) and address(es) in **BLOCK CAPITALS**.
2. Please insert the number of Shares registered in your name and to which this Proxy Form relates. If no such number is inserted, this Proxy Form will be deemed to relate to all the Shares registered in your name.
3. If you are a shareholder who is entitled to attend and vote at the AGM, you are entitled to appoint one or more proxies to attend instead of you and to vote on your behalf. A proxy need not be a shareholder of the Company, but must attend the AGM in person in order to represent you.
4. If any proxy other than the Chairperson of the AGM is appointed, cross out “the Chairperson of the captioned meeting of the Company, or”, and insert the name(s) and address(es) of the proxy (or proxies) desired in the space provided. If no name is inserted, the Chairperson of the AGM will act as your proxy. Any alteration made to this Proxy Form must be signed by the person who originally executed this Proxy Form.
5. **Important: if you wish to vote for any resolution, please insert “✓” in the box marked “For”. If you wish to vote against any resolution, please insert “✓” in the box marked “Against”. If you wish to abstain from voting on any resolution, please insert “✓” in the box marked “Abstention”.** If you return this proxy form without indicating as to how your proxy is to vote on any particular matter, the person appointed as your proxy will exercise his/her discretion as to whether he/she votes and, if so, how and, unless instructed otherwise, he/she may also vote or abstain from voting as he/she thinks fit on any other business (including amendments to resolutions) which may properly come before the AGM. Any vote which is not filled or filled wrongly or with unrecognizable writing or not casted will be deemed as having been waived by you and the corresponding vote will be counted as “Abstention”. The shares abstained will be counted in the calculation of the required majority.
6. This Proxy Form must be signed by you or your attorney duly authorised in writing. Corporations must execute this Proxy Form under common seal or under the hand of any director or attorney duly authorised. If this Proxy form is signed by your attorney duly authorised in writing, the power of attorney or other documents of authorisation (if any) must be notarized.
7. In case of joint holders of any Share, any one of such joint holders may vote at the AGM, either personally or by proxy, in respect of such Shares as if he/she/it is solely entitled thereto. However, if more than one of such joint holders are present at the AGM, personally or by proxy, the vote of the joint holder whose name stands first in the register of members and who tenders a vote, whether in person or by proxy, will be accepted to the exclusion of the votes of other joint holder(s).
8. In order to be valid, this Proxy Form together with any power of attorney or other documents of authorisation (if any) under which it is signed or a notarised copy thereof must be delivered or mailed to Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, the Company’s H Shares registrar, at 17M Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen’s Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong not less than 24 hours before the AGM or any adjournment thereof.
9. Completion and return of the Proxy Form will not preclude you from attending and voting in person at the AGM should you so wish, but in such event the instrument appointing a proxy shall be deemed to be revoked.
10. Shareholders or their proxies attending the AGM shall produce their identity documents.
11. The description of the special resolutions is by way of summary only. The full text of the special resolutions is set out in the circular of the Company dated May 20, 2024.
12. The resolutions at the AGM will be taken by poll. On a poll, every member present in person or by proxy shall be entitled to one vote for each share of the Company registered in his name. The result of such poll shall be deemed to be the resolution of the AGM at which the poll was so taken.
13. All references to date and time herein refer to Hong Kong date and time.
