During the period from 7 May 2024 to 21 May 2024, CISI Investment, an indirect wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company, has acquired the Notes in an aggregate principal amount of US\$6,855,000 (equivalent to approximately HK\$53,811,750) at a total consideration of approximately US\$6,819,728 (equivalent to approximately HK\$53,534,864) on the open market.

To the best knowledge, information and belief of the Directors and having made all reasonable enquiries, the sellers of the Notes and their respective beneficial owners are Independent Third Parties.

The Acquisitions were funded from the Company’s internal resources.

INFORMATION OF THE ISSUER

According to the public information available to the Directors, the Issuer is a Japanese mutual company. It is the core company of the Nippon Life group, which consists of multiple group companies operating life insurance and asset management business in the Asia-Pacific region and globally, and is the largest private asset owner in Japan. The Issuer operates as an insurance company and provides illness, hospitalization, nursing, death, pension, educational, and other life insurance services.

As at the date of this announcement, to the best of the knowledge, information and belief of the Directors, having made all reasonable enquiries, the Issuer and its respective ultimate beneficial owners are Independent Third Parties.

INFORMATION OF THE GROUP

The Group is principally engaged in the provision of brokerage services, margin financing services, corporate finance services, asset management services and financial products and investments.

REASONS AND BENEFITS FOR THE ACQUISITIONS

The Group acquired the Notes for investment purpose. The investment strategy of the Group is, among others, to generate stable return to the Group within an acceptable risk level by investing in a broad diversification of portfolio, including but not limited to stocks, bonds, funds, structured products and derivatives in different business sectors to broaden its revenue streams and to seek sustainable business which increase value for its shareholders. In addition, the Group has sought an opportunity to balance and diversify its investment portfolio when opportunities arose and would, from time to time, realise its investment which to do so will be in the best interests of the Group.

The Directors consider that the Acquisitions provide the Group with an opportunity to balance and diversify its investment portfolio, as well as to generate a stable return to the Group within an acceptable risk level. The Acquisitions are in line with the Group’s investment strategy. The Directors consider that the Acquisitions are fair and reasonable and are in the interests of the Company and the

Shareholders as a whole.
