# CONTINUING CONNECTED TRANSACTION RENEWAL OF BRAND ROYALTY AGREEMENT

On 27 February 2025, the Company and AFS Japan entered into the 2025 Royalty Renewal Agreement, pursuant to which the Company shall pay Royalty to AFS Japan for the use of AEON Trademarks in connection with the Group's Business in the Territory for a further term of one year from 1 March 2025 to 28 February 2026.

As AFS Japan is a Controlling Shareholder of the Company, AFS Japan is a connected person of the Company. Accordingly, the 2025 Royalty Renewal Agreement constitutes a continuing connected transaction of the Company under the Listing Rules.

As each of the applicable percentage ratios for the Annual Cap exceeds 0.1% but is less than 5%, the 2025 Royalty Renewal Agreement is subject to the reporting, announcement and annual review requirements, but exempt from the independent shareholders' approval requirements under Chapter 14A of the Listing Rules.

# BACKGROUND

Reference is made to the announcement of the Company dated 25 November 2024 in relation to the right for the Group to use the AEON Trademarks in connection with the Group's Business in the Territory under the Brand Royalty Agreement.

As the Brand Royalty Agreement will expire on 28 February 2025, the Company has entered into the 2025 Royalty Renewal Agreement with AFS Japan on 27 February 2025 to renew the Brand Royalty Agreement for a further term of one year from 1 March 2025 to 28 February 2026.

# THE 2025 ROYALTY RENEWAL AGREEMENT

# Date

27 February 2025

## Parties

- (a) The Company; and
- (b) AFS Japan.

### **Right to use the AEON Trademarks**

The Group is granted an exclusive right to use the AEON Trademarks in connection with its Business in the Territory under the 2025 Royalty Renewal Agreement.

#### Term

The 2025 Royalty Renewal Agreement is for a term of one year from 1 March 2025 to 28 February 2026. It may be renewed on such terms and conditions as the Company and AFS Japan may mutually agree.

## **Consideration and Payment Terms**

Pursuant to the 2025 Royalty Renewal Agreement, the Company shall pay Royalty to AFS Japan, calculated at a rate of 0.375% on the Group's audited consolidated operating revenue for the financial year ending 28 February 2026, as reported in AFS Japan's audited consolidated financial statements, with adjustments for applicable exchange rates.

Payment of the Royalty shall be made in JPY on a half-yearly basis after receipt of an invoice from AFS Japan expected to be issued in October 2025 and April 2026.

#### **Pricing Basis**

The Royalty rate was determined through arm's length negotiations between the Company and AFS Japan with reference to various factors, including but not limited to (i) the value from the AEON Trademarks as derived by the Group for its Business; (ii) the royalty rates charged by other licensors in similar transactions; (iii) prevailing pricing models for comparable licensing arrangements in the market; and (iv) consistent royalty pricing terms to be applied to the Company and AFS Japan's other subsidiaries.

#### ANNUAL CAP

The maximum annual aggregate Royalty payable by the Company to AFS Japan under the 2025 Royalty Renewal Agreement is estimated to be HK\$9,000,000 (approximately JPY167,000,000) for the year ending 28 February 2026.

The Annual Cap is set based on the Group's audited consolidated operating revenue for the financial year ending 28 February 2026, as to be reported in AFS Japan's audited consolidated financial statements, with a buffer to account for potential appreciation in the JPY.

The 2024 Aggregate Royalty is expected to be not exceeding HK\$4,500,000.

Shareholders should note that the Annual Cap and the 2024 Aggregate Royalty only represent the Company's best estimates of the respective maximum transaction amounts based on information currently available. Neither the Annual Cap nor the 2024 Aggregate Royalty is, or should be interpreted as, indicative of the Group's actual financial performance or its future financial potential in any manner whatsoever.

# REASONS FOR AND BENEFITS OF ENTERING INTO THE 2025 ROYALTY RENEWAL AGREEMENT

The Directors believe that the entering into of the 2025 Royalty Renewal Agreement reflects the Company's ongoing due recognition of the market value of the AEON Trademarks, while contractually ensures their continued use through legal agreement that clearly sets out the related rights and obligations, thereby giving greater certainty and stability to the Group and its operations.

The Directors, including the independent non-executive Directors, are of the view that the 2025 Royalty Renewal Agreement is on normal commercial terms, fair and reasonable, and is entered into in the ordinary and usual course of business of the Company. Furthermore, they believe that the transactions contemplated under the 2025 Royalty Renewal Agreement are in the interests of the Group and the shareholders of the Company as a whole and are on terms no less favourable to the Company than those available from or to independent third parties.

# LISTING RULES IMPLICATIONS

AFS Japan is a Controlling Shareholder of the Company and is interested in approximately 56.54% of the issued shares of the Company. AFS Japan is therefore a connected person of the Company, and the 2025 Royalty Renewal Agreement constitutes a continuing connected transaction of the Company under Chapter 14A of the Listing Rules.

As each of the applicable percentage ratios for the Annual Cap exceeds 0.1% but is less than 5%, the 2025 Royalty Renewal Agreement is subject to the reporting, announcement, and annual review requirements but exempt from the independent shareholders' approval requirements under Chapter 14A of the Listing Rules.

None of the Directors has a material interest in the transactions contemplated under the 2025 Royalty Renewal Agreement, save for Mr. Kenji Fujita who is a director of AFS Japan. Accordingly, Mr. Kenji Fujita has abstained from voting on the Board resolutions approving the 2025 Royalty Renewal Agreement.

AFS Japan is an investment holding company, with subsidiaries being a bank holding company or otherwise conducting banking business, credit card business and/ or other related or ancillary businesses. Formerly known as AEON Credit Service Co., Ltd., AFS Japan has extensive know-how and expertise in the consumer finance industry.
