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ABOUT THIS REPORT

Net-A-Go Technology Company Limited, together with its subsidiaries (the "**Group**"), is pleased to present this Environmental, Social and Governance Report (the "**Report**") to provide an overview of the Group's management on significant issues affecting the operation, and the performance of the Group in terms of environmental and social aspects.

PREPARATION BASIS AND SCOPE

This Report is prepared in accordance with Appendix C2 to the rules governing the listing of securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the "**Stock Exchange**") (the "**Listing Rules**") – "Environmental, Social and Governance Reporting Guide" and has complied with "comply or explain" provision in the Listing Rules.

This Report summarises the performance of the Group in respect of corporate social responsibility, covering its operating activities which are considered as material by the Group - (i) environmental maintenance business in the PRC; (ii) trading business in Hong Kong; and (iii) media advertising business in the PRC. With the aim to optimise and improve the disclosure requirements in the Report, the Group has taken initiative to formulate policies, record relevant data, implement and monitor measures. This Report shall be published both in Chinese and English on the website of Stock Exchange. Should there be any discrepancy between the Chinese and the English versions, the English version shall prevail.

REPORTING PERIOD

This Report demonstrates our sustainability initiatives during the reporting period from 1 January 2024 to 31 December 2024.

網譽科技有限公司連同其附屬公司(「本集 團」) 欣然提呈本環境、社會及管治報告(「本 報告」),以提供有關本集團管理影響其營運 之重大事宜及本集團於環境及社會層面之 表現的概覽。

編製基準及範圍

本報告依照香港聯合交易所有限公司(「聯 交所」)證券上市規則(「上市規則」)附錄C2-「環境、社會及管治報告指引」編製,並遵 守上市規則「不遵守就解釋」條文。

本報告概述本集團對企業社會責任的履行 情況,涵蓋本集團視為重大的經營活動一(i) 於中國的環境維護業務;(ii)於香港的貿易業 務,(iii)於中國媒體廣告業務。為優化及改進 本報告的披露要求,本集團已主動制定政 策、記錄相關數據、實施措施並對其落實情 況加以監督。本報告以中、英文版本在聯交 所網站刊發。中、英文版本如有任何歧義, 概以英文版本為準。

INTRODUCTION

The Group is mainly engaged in environmental maintenance business media advertising business and trading business in the PRC. The scope of environmental maintenance business services mainly include (i) janitorial services on streets, in green belts zones, gullies and other public areas, such as street cleaning, mechanical cleaning and dust removal; (ii) waste management, such as disposal and recycling of solid waste, bulky garbage, construction waste and food waste; and (iii) facility maintenance management, such as provision of cleaning and maintenance services (including minor repair and maintenance) for public facilities, containers and refuse collection points. The Group deploys sufficient cleaning staff and supervisors, specialised vehicles and cleaning equipment in carrying out such specialised cleaning services such as dust removal with the use of mist cannon trucks to reduce haze pollution. In May 2024, the Company started to engage in media advertising business in the PRC and in June 2024, it started to record advertising revenue. The trading business includes cosmetics products trading and securities trading.

The Group has a clear strategy for its business development. In order to achieve sustainable development for affordable capital and long-term competitiveness, we recognise the importance of operating in a responsible manner for the environment and community. The Group remains dedicated to the local communities. More effort is put on optimising our business and on the cost control in an environmentally friendly manner.

The Group is in strict compliance with the legal requirements in the area we operate. Various policies and procedures have been established based on the compliance of law and business development strategies of the Group. These policies and procedures can help us to manage and monitor the risks related to the environment, employment, operating practices and community. Details of the management approaches to sustainable development of different areas are illustrated in this Report.

緒言

本集團主要於中國從事環境維護業務,媒體 廣告業務及於貿易業務。環境維護業務服 務的範圍主要包括(i)街道、綠化帶、溝渠及 其他公共區域的保潔服務,如街道清潔、機 械化清掃及除塵;(ii)廢棄物管理,如處置及 回收固體廢棄物、大型垃圾、建築廢棄物及 廚餘垃圾;及(ii)公共設施、盛器及垃圾收集 站設施的維護管理,如提供清潔及維護服務 (包括小型維修及維護)。進行除塵等專門 清潔服務時,本集團部署足夠的清潔工及監 工、專門車輛及清潔設備,如使用霧炮車以 減少霧霾污染。於二零二四年五月,本公司 開始於中國從事媒體廣告業務,並於二零 二四年六月開始錄得廣告收入。貿易業務包 括化妝品貿易及證券買賣業務。

本集團訂有明確的業務發展戰略。為實現可 負擔資本的可持續發展及長期競爭力,我 們認識到以負責任的態度經營環境及社區 的重要性。本集團持續致力於當地社區的發 展。本集團以環保方式加大力度優化業務及 進行成本控制。

本集團嚴格遵守我們經營所在地的法律規 定。本集團已按照法律合規及業務發展策略 制定各項政策及程序。該等政策及程序有助 於本集團管理及監察與環境、僱傭、經營實 踐及社區相關的風險。不同範疇的可持續發 展管理方式詳情於本報告闡述。

ESG GOVERNANCE

Board's oversight of ESG issues

Board's overall vision and strategy in managing ESG issues

The board of directors (**"Board**") has a primary role in overseeing the management of the Group's sustainability issues. During the year, the Board spent significant time in evaluating the impact of ESG-related risks on our operation and formulating relevant policy in dealing with the risks. The oversight of the Board is to ensure the management to have all the right tools and resources to oversee the ESG issues in the context of strategy and long-term value creation.

ESG working group

The Group attaches great importance to ESG work. Under the leadership of the Board of the Company, each subsidiary has set up a dedicated safety and environmental protection department ("**ESG Working Group**") to implement specific safety and environmental protection work, so as to comply with government requirements, implement the concept of "safety and environmental protection" in its operation and fulfil its social responsibilities.

The ESG Working Group is primarily responsible for reviewing and supervising the ESG process, and risk management of the Group. Different ESG issues were reviewed by the Working Group at the meeting, which holds once per year. During the reporting period, the ESG Working Group and the management reviewed the ESG governance and different ESG issues.

環境、社會及管治的治理 董事會對環境、社會及管治事宜 的監督工作

董事會於管理環境、社會及管治 事宜的整體視野及策略

董事會(「董事會」)局負監督本集團可持續 發展事宜的管理的主要職責。年內,董事會 耗用大量時間評估環境、社會及管治相關風 險對我們營運的影響,並制定處理此等風險 的有關政策。董事會監督工作為確保管理層 擁有所有適當工具及資源,於策略及長期價 值創造方面監管環境、社會及管治事宜。

環境、社會及管治工作小組

本集團非常重視環境、社會及管治工作。在 本公司董事會的領導下,各附屬公司均已成 立盡心盡力的安全及環境保護部門(「環境、 社會及管治工作小組」),以實行具體的安全 及環保工作,例如遵守政府規定、於營運中 落實「安全及環保」概念及履行其社會責任。

環境、社會及管治工作小組主要負責檢討及 監管本集團的環境、社會及管治流程以及風 險管理。工作小組在每年舉行一次的會議上 審視不同的環境、社會及管治事宜。於報告 期內,環境、社會及管治工作小組與管理層 審視環境、社會及管治的治理以及不同的環 境、社會及管治事宜。



董事會對重大環境、社會及管治 相關事宜的環境、社會及管治方 針及策略

為了更透徹了解不同持份者對環境、社會及 管治事宜的意見及期望,我們每年進行重大 性評估。我們確保有多個平台及溝通渠道可 用以接觸、聆聽及回應主要持份者。透過與 持份者的正常溝通,本集團了解持份者的期 望及關注問題。所獲得的反饋讓本集團得以 作出知情決定以及更妥善評估及管理所帶 來的影響。

本集團透過以下步驟評估環境、社會及管治 層面的重大性及重要性:(1)以行業標準識別 重大的環境、社會及管治範疇;(2)結合持份 者參與將關鍵環境、社會及管治範圍按緩急 輕重排序;及(3)基於持份者與管理層的溝通 結果,驗證及釐定重大環境、社會及管治事 宜。因此,本集團加深了解持份者對各重要 環境、社會及管治事宜關注的程度及轉變, 讓我們更加全面地規劃未來的可持續發展 工作。我們於重大性評估中識別的該等重要 及重大的環境、社會及管治範圍於本報告內 討論。

Board's ESG management approach and strategy for material ESG-related issues

In order to better understand the opinions and expectations of different stakeholders on our ESG issues, materiality assessment is conducted each year. We ensure various platforms and channels of communication are used to reach, listen and respond to our key stakeholders. Through general communication with stakeholders, the Group understands the expectations and concerns from stakeholders. The feedbacks obtained allow the Group to make more informed decisions, and to better assess and manage the resulting impact.

The Group has evaluated the materiality and importance in ESG aspects through the steps: (1) material ESG area identification by industry benchmarking; (2) key ESG area prioritization with stakeholder engagement; and (3) validation and determining material ESG issues based on results of communication among stakeholders and the management. Hence, this can enhance understanding of their degree and change of attention to each significant ESG issue, and can enable us to more comprehensively plan our sustainable development work in the future. Those important and material ESG areas identified during our material assessment were discussed in this Report.

A. ENVIRONMENTAL ASPECTS

In response to the national call for green, low-carbon and highquality development, the Group is committed to fulfil sustainable development and engaged preservation of resources with its environmental responsibility. As the Group is engaged in providing environment maintenance services in the PRC during the reporting period, the Group measures and manages its environmental performance in several aspects throughout its daily business operations. In order to achieve these objectives, the Group promotes environmental stewardship throughout its business ecosystem by introducing a number of measures to enhance the environmental protection awareness among its employees, encouraging them to develop environment-friendly working habits and to take action in protecting the precious environment.

Aspect A1: Reduction of emissions

Aspect A1.1 Reduction of fuel consumption emissions and greenhouse gas emissions

A1.1 Gas fuel consumption emissions

Air pollution has become one of the major environmental problems in cities. To protect the vicinity environment, the cleaning and maintenance services involves the use of vehicles for the environmental maintenance business in the PRC. The Group's emission complies with "Emission Limits of Air Pollutants (DB44/27-2001)" and the Atmospheric Pollution Prevention and Control Law of the People's Republic of China (2015) in the PRC.

A. 環境層面

為響應國家建設綠色、低碳、高質量 發展轉型的號召,本集團矢志恪守環 境責任,以實現可持續發展,促進資 源保護。於報告期內,由於本集團於 中國提供環境維護服務,本集團於其 日常業務營運過程中從若干層面衡 量及管理其環保表現。為達致該等目 標,本集團通過採取多種措施提升員 工的環保意識,鼓勵員工養成環保的 工作習慣並採取行動保護寶貴的環 境治理。

層面A1:減少排放物

層面A1.1減少燃料消耗排放 及溫室氣體排放

A1.1 氣體燃料消耗排放 大氣污染已成為城市的主要環 境問題之一。為保護鄰近環境, 在中國的環境維護業務中的清 潔及維護服務中牽涉了用車。 本集團的排放符合中國的「大 氣污染物排放限值」(DB44/27-2001)及中華人民共和國大氣污 染防治法(2015年)的規定。





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We have implemented the following measures to minimize air emissions and their effects during our business operations. For the securities trading business, effective management and control are imposed on the use, maintenance and fuel consumption of vehicles in order to minimize the fuel consumption and air pollutant emissions of vehicles. For the environmental maintenance business, comprehensive targets of the renewal of vehicles have been set. Starting from 2021-2025, traditional fuel vehicles will be gradually replaced by alternative fuel vehicles, such as pure electric vehicles and light fuel vehicles, with a renewal rate of 5%. In 2026-2030, the Group plans to replace 30% of traditional fuel vehicles by alternative fuel vehicles. The Group targets to reduce the consumption of petrol and diesel by 65% and 80% respectively in 2030 and to reduce the emission of air pollutants by 5% by 2025. During the Reporting Period, the reduction in the Group's total emissions of air pollutants was mainly due to the more efficient arrangements made by our fleet. Details are as follows:

我們已實施以下措施,把業務 營運過程中的氣體排放及其影 響減至最低。對於證券買賣業 務,我們有效管理及控制對車 輛的使用、維護及燃油消耗以 盡量減少車輛的燃油消耗及大 氣污染物排放。對於環境維護 業務,我們已制定全面的車輛 汰換目標。自二零二一年至二 零二五年,傳統燃料車輛將逐 漸被替代燃料車輛(如純電動 車及輕燃料車)取代,汰換率為 5%。於二零二六年至二零三零 年,本集團計劃將30%的傳統燃 料車輛替換為替代燃料車輛, 本集團的目標是在二零三零年 將汽油及柴油的消耗分別減少 65%及80%,及於二零二五年前 將大氣污染物排放減少5%。報 告期內,本集團大氣污染物排 放總排放減少主要是由於我們 車隊作出了更具效率的安排。 詳情如下:

A1.2 Greenhouse Gas ("GHG") Emissions during the year Climate change is gradually concerned by the community as it affects our daily life and poses a risk to our business. Hence, the Group is committed to mitigating the effects of climate change and to protect the health of employees. GHG is considered as one of the major contributors of the climate change.

Regarding GHG emissions of the Group, scope 1 direct emissions mainly result from combustion of fuels in mobile sources such as vehicles. Scope 2 indirect emissions mainly result from purchased electricity.

Giving the majority of the GHG emissions of the Group come from the use of electricity and the vehicle fossil fuel consumption of the environmental maintenance business, securities trading business and medical devices business, the Group tackles the GHG emissions by lowering the energy consumption in our business operations. Policies and procedures as mentioned in the section "Use of Resources" to encourage energy saving have been incorporated throughout the operations in order to reduce the carbon footprint.

The detail of GHG emissions of the Group during the reporting period are as follows:

A1.2 年內溫室氣體排放 由於氣候變化影響我們的日常 生活並對本集團業務構成風

險,故受到社會日益關注。因 此,本集團承諾減輕氣候變化 之影響,並保障員工健康。溫室 氣體被視為造成氣候變化的主 要因素之一。

關於本集團的溫室氣體排放, 範圍1直接排放主要來自車輛等 移動源的燃料燃燒。範圍2間接 排放主要來自外購電力。

鑒於本集團的溫室氣體排放大 多來自環境維護業務,證券買 賣業務,醫療器械業務電力使 用及車輛化石燃料消耗,本集 團通過降低業務營運中的能源 消耗來解決溫室氣體排放問 題。於「資源使用」一節所述的鼓 勵節能政策及程序已納入整個 營運過程,以減少碳足跡。

於報告期內,本集團溫室氣體 排放詳情如下:

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The reduction in scope 1 and 2 –direct and indirect greenhouse gas emissions is mainly due to that energy saving technologies are deployed effectively by the Group during the year to improve the operating practices to reduce the energy consumptions and greenhouse gases emissions. Furthermore, the Group targets to reduce the emission of GHG emissions by 5% by 2025.

Aspect A1.4 Reduction of generation of non-hazardous waste

Waste management is considered as one of the material topics in environmental protection. The Group recognizes the importance of waste reduction. Waste management measures have been introduced and implemented to minimize the amount of waste generated and the impact on the environment.

The non-hazardous wastes generated from our securities trading business, environmental maintenance business and media advertising business mainly consist of paper waste and office waste which is insignificant. The Group has established clear and concrete guidelines on waste management. Wastes are separated into recyclable, hazardous and non-hazardous waste, and are stored separately. The Group has appointed different recyclers in different sites to collect recyclable wastes, such as scrap paper and scrap paper box regularly. In addition, to reduce the need for landfills, our administrative operations continue to use paperless electronic communications.

The decrease in the amount of non-hazardous waste in 2024 was mainly due to the effective implementation of waste management policies during the year. Furthermore, the Group targets to reduce the non-hazardous wastes generation by 5% by 2025. The detail of waste generated by the Group during the reporting period is as follows:

我們的證券買賣業務,環境維護業務 和媒體廣告業務所產生的無害廢棄物 主要包括廢紙及少量辦公室廢棄物。 本集團已就廢棄物管理制定清晰具 體的指引。廢棄物分類為可回收、有 害及無害廢棄物後便分開存放。本集 團已於不同地點委派不同的回收商, 定期收集廢紙及廢紙箱等可回收廢棄 物。另外,為減少對堆填區的需求,我 們的行政營運繼續採用無紙化電子通 訊的做法。

A2. Use of resources

The Group considers environmental protection as an essential component of a sustainable and responsible business. The Group has an in-depth understanding of the importance of safeguarding sustainable development of the environment and this to attach importance to efficient utilization of resources by introducing various measures in daily business operations. It understands that staff participation is the key to achieve such goals. The Group strives to build up a working environment that emphasizes the "Green office" and "Low Carbon" policy such as a set of guidelines to improve the efficient use of resources for long-term sustainability. The Group has also adopted policies such as "Energy Resource Control Procedure" to improve the efficient use of energy, water and other materials.

The Group considers environmental protection as an essential component of a sustainable and responsible business. With aims of resource saving and implementation of energy saving measures, the Group actively promotes the concept of energy saving and emission reduction into the entire process of its business development and operation and implements different energy saving measures. The Group supports energy conservation by using energy-saving lightings, switching off idle lightings, computers and electrical appliance. Energy conservation reminders are placed to increase employees' awareness of energy saving. We will consistently seek ways to improve energy efficiency and reduce energy consumption in our facilities in the future.

A2. 資源使用





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The Group's energy consumption consists of three types – (i) purchased electricity, (ii) petrol, and (iii) diesel. During the year, diesel was our major energy consumption sources in our business operations. In 2024, the Group effectively reduced the use of vehicles, and the energy consumption decreased during the year. The Group has set reduction target by 5% in energy consumption by 2025. Aspect A2.2 Water consumption

Water is another important resource used for the daily operation. We encourage staff to reduce the daily water use. Furthermore, water pipes and taps are checked regularly to detect leakage. Regarding water consumption for the PRC office, water supply is solely controlled and centrally managed by its respective property management of the buildings, in this case, it is not feasible for the Hong Kong office to provide all relevant water consumption data as there is no separate water meter for the individual office unit to record water usage.

The Group still actively seeks ways to mitigate water consumption by raising employees' awareness of water saving through green office policy. For example, we studied various water conservation measures, including regular inspection of equipment for water leakage and raising employees' awareness of water conservation.

Since water saving policies were implemented effectively, the water consumption decreased slightly during the year. Furthermore, the Group targets to reduce the water consumption by 5% by 2025. The detail of water consumption of the Group during the reporting period is as follows:

Aspect A3: Impact on environment and natural resources

The Group understands that its environment maintenance business can cause significant environmental impacts. As a responsible environment maintenance business operator, the Group has attached great importance to improve resources efficiency and reduce energy consumption.

To minimise the impact on the environment, we have incorporated energy saving, emissions reduction and environmental protection in our daily business operations. We put energy saving, water saving, electricity saving and emissions reduction as the main focus and have set up related monitoring policies and control measures. This not only can enable waste reduction to relieve the burden on the environment, but also the economic benefit can be maximized for the Group.

層面A3:對環境及天然 資源的影響

本集團深知其環境維護業務可 能對環境造成重大影響。作為 負責任的環境維護業務營運 商,本集團極其重視提高資源 效益及減少能源消耗。

為盡量減少對環境的影響,我 們已將節能、減排及環境保護 納入日常業務經營。我們重點 關注節能、節水、節電及減排, 並已設定相關監察政策及控制 措施。這不僅可減少產生垃圾 以減輕環境負擔,亦能為本集 團帶來最大化經濟效益。



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The Group is committed to becoming an enterprise leading the sustainable development of environment, implementing various green projects in its investment, and creating an energysaving workplace. Over the years, the Group has adopted the following measures in a proactive manner to minimize potential environmental impacts in daily operations. For example, as part of its communication strategy, major communications are primarily conducted electronically, reducing the use of paper. Other environmental management measures of the Group include:

- Encourage customers to use electronic invoices
- Enhance employees' environmental awareness through education; and
- Replace high power consumption lamps with LED lamps

A4. Climate change

Governance

Our group addresses climate-related risks based on the nature of the risk to our operations. The physical impacts of climate change, including extreme weather events, or damage to facilities have immediate operational impacts and are treated as operational risks. Long-term challenges, such as emerging ESG issues and climate-related risks and opportunities, may be discussed by the Group's ESG Working Group.

Supported by our ESG Working Group, our Board oversees climate-related issues and risks regularly during board meetings and ensures that they are incorporated into our strategy.

A4. 氣候變化 *管治*

本集團根據業務風險的性質應 對與氣候相關的風險。氣候變 化的實際影響(包括極端天氣事 件或對設備的損害)會直接影響 營運並被視為營運風險。本集 團環境、社會及管治工作小組 或會對新出現的環境、社會及 管治問題及氣候相關的風險及 機遇等長期挑戰進行討論。

在環境、社會及管治工作小組 的支援下,董事會於董事會會 議上定期監督氣候相關事宜及 風險,並確保將氣候相關事宜 及風險納內策略之中。







To ensure our Board to keep up with the latest trend of climaterelated issues, climate competence training will be provided to ensure it has the necessary expertise and skills to oversee the management of climate-related issues. Our Board also seeks professional advice from external experts when necessary to better support the decision-making process.

Our ESG Working Group provides effective governance for integrating and addressing ESG issues, including climate change, within our business. The ESG Working Group is responsible for approving operational emissions targets for the Group and commissioning an ESG benchmarking, as well as gap analysis exercise to identify gaps in both disclosure and policy relative to the best practice standards. Moreover, the ESG Working Group works closely with the Group's different operation departments, with an aim to develop consistent and enhanced approaches on addressing ESG risk issues and report to the management. 為確保董事會緊貼氣候相關事 宜的最新趨勢,董事會獲提供 氣候能力培訓,確保其具有必 需的專業知識及技能以監督氣 候相關事宜的管理。於需要時, 董事會亦向外部專家尋求專業 意見,以更妥善支持決策過程。

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Strategy

Climate change risk forms part of our overall risk profile through its role in increasing the frequency and intensity of certain diseases, and the health and mortality impacts resulting from natural disasters. We assess the overall level of risk by taking into consideration a range of diverse risk factors across the many categories in our product or services range. This diversity of risk is combined with our business strategy and broad geographic footprint helps us distribute risk and provide protection against the impacts of short-term climate change effects.

Our services continue to provide protection for people in our communities against weather and heat-related disease. Besides, we continue to explore opportunities to engage our business partners and encourage them to develop climate resilience and reduce their operational carbon footprint by taking into consideration of different climate-related scenarios, including a "2°C or lower scenario" through the following steps:

策略

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Step 1: Set Future Images Assuming Climate Change Effects

As climate change measures proceeds, there is a possibility that the industry will be exposed to substantial changes, such as stricter policies including the introduction of and increases in carbon pricing, as well as advances in technology and changes in customer awareness. In light of these climate change effects, based on the International Energy Agency ("**IEA**") scenarios and others, we developed multiple future images as the external environment that will surround our Group.

With regard to the IEA scenarios, we put focus on the 2°C scenario (2DS) and pictured future images in case where climate change measures do not progress and where such measures progress further "Beyond 2°C scenario".

Step 2: Consider the Impacts

We considered the impacts on our Group for each of the future images developed in Step 1. We believe that it will be possible to expedite carbon dioxide reduction effects in our society.

With regard to the effects on raw material procurement and production, introduction of and increases in carbon pricing is anticipated in accordance with the global advance of climate change measures, leading to the possibility of higher raw material procurement and production costs.

On the other hand, in the case where climate change measures are not adequate throughout society, production interruptions and supply chain disruptions are likely to increase as a result of higher frequency and intensification of natural disasters such as flooding.

第一步:設定氣候變化影響可能 造成的未來場景

隨著應對氣候變化措施的持續落實,行業可 能面臨重大變化,例如推出及上調碳定價等 更嚴厲的政策,以及技術進步和客戶觀念的 變化。鑒於該等氣候變化影響,我們基於國 際能源署(「IEA」)發佈的情景及其他情景設 定了本集團將面對的外部周圍環境的多種 未來場景。

關於IEA情景,我們重點關注2℃情景(2DS),並 分別製作在氣候變化應對措施並無進展及 該等措施進展逾越「2℃情景以外」兩種情況 下的未來場景。

第二步:考慮影響

我們已考慮第一步所設定的各種未來場景 對本集團造成的影響。我們認為在社會環境 中,可能須加大二氧化碳減排力度。

就對原材料採購及生產的影響而言,隨著全 球加強氣候變化應對措施,預計將推出及上 調碳定價,進而可能推高原材料採購和生產 成本。

另一方面,當針對整個社會的氣候變化應對 措施不足時,因洪水等自然災害發生的頻率 變高且程度加劇而導致生產停頓和供應鏈 中斷的可能性將會增加。







Step 3: Respond to the Strategies

Our Group will begin promoting the reduction of non-renewable energy in our daily operation. This strategy will allow for flexible and strategic responses to each demand for the regions where the emission factors of purchased electricity consumptions are high. By promoting real carbon emissions reductions throughout the world through these types of initiatives, we are working to achieve zero carbon emission in our business.

We minimize carbon emissions through comprehensive energy-saving and introduction of renewable energy. With respect to renewable energy in particular, we have set a new target, achieve a reduction rate for purchased electricity in coming few years.

With regard to the ongoing confirmation of the suitability and progress of the Group's strategies, we believe that we will have opportunities for stable funding and sustainable increases in corporate value through appropriate information disclosure, dialogue with institutional investors and other stakeholders.

第三步:戰略對策

本集團將開始在日常營運中推廣減少不可 再生能源的使用。該策略可以靈活及策略性 地應對外購用電的排放係數較高地區的需 求。這些舉措促進了全世界碳排放的真正減 少,同時,我們正致力於營運內實現零碳排 放。

我們通過全面節能及引入可再生能源以減 少碳排放。具體而言,於可再生能源方面, 我們已設定於未來數年減少外購電量的新 目標。

對於持續確認本集團策略的適切性和進展,我們相信通過適當的資料露、與機構投 資者及其他持份者的溝通,我們將有機會獲 得穩定資金及實現企業價值的可持續增長。



Risk Management

Our Group identifies the climate change related risks or to test the existing risk management strategies under climate change with the aid of risk assessment. Hence, the areas where new strategies are needed could be identified.

The risk assessment takes a standard risk-based approach using national data, local information and expert knowledge, which can identify how climate change may compound existing risks or create new ones. The risk assessment is conducted through the following steps:

Step 1: Establish the context

- Objective/goal
- Scale
- Time frame
- Climate change scenario for most climate variables and sea level

Step 2: Identify existing risk (past and current)

- Identify the record of occurrence of climatic hazard in the past in the area
- Risk management strategies in place to tackle future occurrence of the hazard

Step 3: Identify future risk and opportunities

- Explore climate change projections for the selected time frame(s) and emission scenario(s)
- Identify potential hazards
- Investigate whether any existing risk from Step 2 may get worse under future projected changes
- Identify new risks that can emerge under future projected changes

風險管理

本集團已確定氣候變化相關風險或借助風 險評估測試在氣候變化下現有的風險管理 策略。因此能夠發現需要實施新策略的領 域。

風險評估採用基於風險的標準方法,並利用 國家數據、本地資料及專家知識,能夠識別 氣候變化如何加劇現有風險或產生新風險。 該風險評估按以下步驟進行:

第一步:建立背景

- 目標/願景
- 規模
- 時間表
- 根據多數氣候可變因素及海平面設定
 的氣候變化情景

第二步:確定現有風險(過去及現 在)

- 搜集本地區過去發生氣候災害的記錄
- 現有可應對未來災害的風險管理策略

第三步:確定未來的風險及機遇

- 探索選定時間範圍內及排放情景下的 氣候變化預測
- 識別潛在危害
- 根據未來預測變化分析第二步的任何
 現有風險是否可能加劇
 - 識別未來預測變化中可能出現的新風 險



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Step 4: Analyse and evaluate risk

Identify a set of decision areas or systems (i.e., geographical areas, business operation, assets, ecosystems, etc.) that has the potential to be at risk in future.

As outlined within the Governance section above, the Group has robust risk management and business planning processes that are overseen by the board of directors in order to identify, assess and manage climaterelated risks. The Group engages with government and other appropriate organizations in order to keep abreast of expected and potential regulatory and/or fiscal changes.

We continue to raise awareness of climate change in regard to monitoring of carbon and energy footprint in our daily operation. However, there remains gaps in understanding how such climate risks and opportunities may impact our operations, assets and profits. Our Group assesses how the business addresses climate change risks and opportunities and takes the initiative to monitor and reduce their environmental footprint.

Emergency Management of Environmental Events

The Group has established an emergency mechanism for environmental emergencies and formulated the Emergency Plan for Environmental Emergencies according to the actual situation of subsidiaries, so as to ensure that all emergency work can be started quickly, efficiently and orderly in case of environmental emergencies, and minimise the harm to the environment and the loss of business operation caused by environmental emergencies.

第四步:分析及評估風險

誠如上文管治一節所述,本集團擁有穩健有 效的風險管理及業務規劃流程,該等流程受 董事會監督,以識別、評估及管理氣候相關 風險。本集團將與政府及其他合適的機構合 作,與時俱進,掌握預期及可能作出的監管 及/或財政政策變動。

我們不斷加強有關氣候變化的意識,於日常 營運中監控碳及能源足跡。然而,在理解該 等氣候風險及機遇可能如何影響我們的營 運、資產及溢利方面仍存在不足之處。本集 團評估業務如何應對氣候變化的風險及機 遇,並採取措施以監控並減少其環境影響。

環境事件應急管理

本集團設立了突發環境事件應急機制,並根 據各成員企業的實際情況制定《突發環境事 件應急預案》,以確保在發生突發環境事件 時,各項應急工作能夠快速及高效有序地啟 動,最大限度地減輕突發環境事件對環境造 成的危害和業務運作的損失。





Responding to Climate Change

Climate change has a far-reaching impact on economic and social development, which is an environmental challenge facing the world at present. Global climate change not only brings extreme weather, but also seriously affects various kinds of economic and social activities. According to the research of the World Health Organisation, about 12 million people die of environmental factors every year.

At the end of 2015, the Paris Agreement was officially adopted and became a new legally binding treaty on global greenhouse gas reduction following the Kyoto Protocol. In September 2020, President Xi Jinping delivered an important speech at the General Debate of the 75th Session of the United Nations General Assembly, pointing out that China shall scale up its intended nationally determined contributions, strive to peak carbon dioxide emissions by 2030, and achieve carbon neutrality by 2060.

The Group pays attention to the impact of climate change on human health, actively identifies the risks and opportunities brought by climate change to its operation and confirms the impact of its operation on climate and environment.

應對氣候變化

氣候變化為經濟和社會發展帶來的影響深 遠,是當前全球共同面對的環境挑戰。全球 氣候變化不僅帶來極端天氣現象,更嚴重影 響各類經濟和社會活動。根據世界衛生組織 的研究,全球每年有約1,200萬人由於環境因 素而過早死亡。

2015年底,《巴黎協議》正式通過,成為繼京 都議定書之後對全球溫室氣體減量具有法 律約束力的新協議。2020年9月,國家主席習 近平在第七十五屆聯合國大會一般性辯論 上發表重要講話,指出中國將提高國家自主 貢獻力度,二氧化碳排放力爭於2030年前達 到峰值,努力爭取2060年前實現碳中和。

本集團關注氣候變化為人類健康帶來的影響,積極識別氣候變化為公司經營帶來風險 和機遇,同時識別自身運營過程中對氣候和 環境造成的影響。

METRICS AND TARGETS

Our Group adopts the key metrics to assess and manage climate-related risks and opportunities. The energy consumption and greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions indicators are the key metrics used to assess and manage relevant climate-related risks where we consider such information is material and crucial for evaluating the impact of our operation on global climate change during the year. Our Group regularly tracks our energy consumption and GHG emissions indicators to assess the effectiveness of emission reduction initiatives, as well as set targets to contribute our effort to have minimal impact on global warming. The details of time frames over which the target applies and base year from which progress is measured are described in the section A1: "Emissions" and section A2: "Use of Resources" of this Report. Our Group adopts absolute target to manage climate-related risks, opportunities and performance.

B. SOCIAL ASPECTS

The Group recognizes that maintenance of strong, healthy and friendly business relations with employees, supply chains, and a business is connected or expected to have a connection, whether internal or external, is the foundation for the Group's success and development. The Group highly considers employees as important assets and is committed to earning respect from employees, maintaining work-life balance, and making them to grow together with us. With supporting business sustainable development, the Group works closely with suppliers to manage social risks. Besides, with a goal of understand the needs and interests of communities where the issuer operates, the Group takes its own initiatives to actively contribute to the society in various ways.

B1. Employment

The Group believes that people are important assets and are crucial to the business success of the Group. We are committed to providing a favourable working environment where our employees can thrive. We have a set of human resources management policies and procedures in place with the aim to provide a good working environment to employees where they can have a safe and healthy workplace to engage and perform to the satisfaction of the Group. These policies and procedures do not only ensure the Group's compliance of the relevant labour laws and regulations in the PRC and Hong Kong, but also set out the Group's standard of staff recruitment, promotion guidelines, remuneration scale, working hours, rest periods, equal opportunity, diversity, anti-discrimination and other benefits and welfare as well as termination of employment and compensation matters.

In this year, there was no case of non-compliance related to labour and employment practices nor complaints in relation to discrimination within the Group.

The Group recruits and promotes people based on the principles of people foremost, equal stress on integrity and ability, and meritocracy regardless of their nationality, age, religion, marital status and other factors. All employees are remunerated according to their performance, experience and prevailing industry practices. We take a firm stand against the vicious competition, and sexual, age, ethnic, or any other discrimination, and are determined to put an end to the discrimination in courses such as recruitment, promotion, training and dismissal of employees and will ensure equal opportunities for all. At the same time, the Company actively attracts talents with diverse educational, ethnic and nationality backgrounds.

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Aspect B2: Health and safety

The Group regards occupational health and safety as its most important aspect of corporate risk management. As a company caring for our employees, we are committed to maintaining a healthy and safe work environment in compliance with all relevant Hong Kong and the PR laws and regulations.

The Group follows the occupational health and safety guidelines recommended by the Labour Department of Hong Kong. Besides, the Group strictly complies with Occupational Safety and Health Ordinance and Law of the PRC on the Prevention and Treatment of Occupational Diseases. During the year, 24 cases of work-related injuries (2021: 92 cases, 2022: 56 cases, 2023: 33 cases) and 1 case of work-related fatalities (2021: 4 cases, 2022: 0 case, 2023: 1 case) occurred, while the number of lost days due to work injury was 120 days (2021: 120 days, 2022: 120 days, 2023: 120 days).

The Group not only strictly abides by the Labour Law of the People's Republic of China, the Fire Protection Law of the People's Republic of China, the Law of the People's Republic of China on the Prevention and Control of Occupational Diseases, the Production Safety Law of the People's Republic of China and the Regulations on Work Injury Insurance, but also proactively formulates internal policies and standards related to specific business departments of the Group. The Group attaches great importance to occupational health and safety as the key focus for our operation is to ensure the safety and wellbeing of the employees. For this reason, a comprehensive occupational health and safety management system has been established. The Group arranges safety training for pre-employment employees and each employee according to their job position to strengthen their knowledge of health and safety

Every employee is provided with safety equipment and clothing which is checked regularly to ensure proper usage and functioning when performing environment maintenance services. They are also provided with medical check annually. First aid equipment is equipped in the workplace for prompt responses to any injuries and incidents happened. The Group has also arranged irregular seminar on emergency drills such as first aid, fire-fighting, evacuation, leakage and escape to improve staff safety awareness. The Group stringently complied with the Employees' Compensation Ordinance, Chapter 282, Laws of Hong Kong relating to the provision of safe working environment and protecting employees from occupational hazards.

Aspect B3: Development and training

The Group is committed to providing continuous training and learning opportunities to employees to develop their talents and to expand the Group's business. The Group has provided numerous development opportunities throughout the year to employees at all levels to continuously strengthen employee's skill in order to enhance the Group's competitiveness for sustainable business growth.

The Group has established relevant development and training systems with the aim to promote a learning culture for improvement. Employees are encouraged and have equal opportunities to participate in different training programmes. Subsidies and supports are given to employees to participate in the relevant training courses.

Training is particularly focused on safety training which is our primary concern. Safety training covers a wide range of topics, including safety production procedures, occupational hazard, etc. to ensure all employees acquire proper skills and knowledge before performing the assigned tasks. With continuous safety training, not only the employees' safety knowledge and awareness can be increased, but also the occurrence of work-related accidents can be reduced. 本集團為各僱員提供安全設備及服 裝,並定期進行檢查,以確保於提供 環境維護服務時正確使用及發揮作 用。本集團亦每年為僱員提供體檢。 工作場所配備有急救設備,以便及時 處理發生的任何傷害及事故。本集團 亦安排不定期的急救、消防、疏散、洩 漏及逃生等應急演練研討會,提升僱 員安全意識。本集團嚴格遵守香港法 例第282章僱員補償條例有關安全工 作環境及保障僱員不受職業危害的條 文。

層面B3:發展及培訓

本集團致力於為員工提供持續的培訓 及學習機會,以開發彼等的才能及擴 展本集團業務。於整個年度內,本集 團已為各級員工提供大量發展機會, 以不斷增強員工技能,從而提升本集 團於可持續業務增長方面之競爭力。

本集團已建立有關發展及培訓系統, 旨在弘揚積極進步的學習文化。本集 團鼓勵員工而員工亦享有平等機會參 與各類培訓計劃。我們會就僱員參與 有關培訓課程向僱員發放補貼及提供 資助。

培訓內容尤其著重安全方面,乃我們 首要關注之問題。安全培訓涵蓋安全 生產程序、職業危害等多種課題,以 確保全體員工在執行所分派任務之前 獲得適當的技能及知識。通過持續的 安全培訓,不僅可提高僱員的安全知 識及安全意識,亦可減少發生與工作 有關的事故。





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Apart from safety training in enhancing the safety performance, orientation training is provided for new employees to familiarise with the corporate culture and the background of the Group. Training offered to employees depends on the job position of employees and the development of the Group.

Regular assessment is conducted to keep track on the performance of the employees for the purpose of formulating further training plans, job promotion and salary adjustment. The Group will enhance the training system in order to improve the personal development of employees.

The detailed breakdown of the percentage of employees trained by gender and employment category is as follows:

The Group is committed to protecting human rights in workplace and has zero tolerance to the use of child or forced labour during our operation. The Group understands that child labour and forced labour violate fundamental human rights and international labour conventions and may constitute threat to the social and economic sustainability.

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Therefore, the Group has implemented policies, including "Prohibition of Child Labour Regulation" to strictly prohibit the recruitment of child labour and the use of forced labour. If there is any confirmed case, the Group must report to the related authorities immediately. Our commitment to human rights extends to supply chain. Suppliers are expected to follow the same standard of labour practices when working with us.

During the reporting period, the Group was in full compliance with all the applicable labour laws and regulations including Labour Law of the People's Republic of China, the Labour Contract Law of the People's Republic of China, the Provisions on the Prohibition of Using Child Labour and other national laws and regulations as well as the Provisions on the Prohibition of Using Child Labour and the Employment of Children Regulations in Hong Kong. Recruitment and employment are carried out in strict compliance with relevant laws and regulations such as the Employment Ordinance, Chapter 57, Laws of Hong Kong and the guidelines issued by the human resources department. In 2024, Net-a-Go Technology did not have any cases related to child labour or forced labour. 因此,本集團已實施包括「禁止使用童 工規定」在內的政策,嚴禁招聘童工 和使用強迫勞工。如確定存在任何相 關情況,本集團須立即向有關部門匯 報。我們對人權的承諾已延伸至供應 鏈。供應商與我們合作時,應遵守相 同的勞工常規準則。

於報告期內,本集團完全遵守所有適 用的勞動法律及法規,包括《中華人民 共和國勞動法》《中華人民共和國勞動 合同法》《禁止使用童工規定》等國家 法律法規以及香港禁止使用童工規定 及僱用兒童規例的規定。有關招聘及 僱用必須嚴格遵守相關法律及法規, 如香港法例第57章僱傭條例以及人力 資源部頒佈的指引。2024年,網譽科 技未發生僱傭童工、強制勞工等違法 事件。



OPERATING PRACTICES

Aspect B5: Supply chain management

The Group recognises suppliers, vendors and contractors as valuable stakeholders within the supply chain as their responsible business behaviours are important in contributing to quality excellence, operational efficiency and good reputation of the Group. We strive to cooperate with local suppliers whenever possible to promote local economy and strengthen the control of environmental risks related to supply chain management. During the reporting period, the Group had 83 suppliers (2023: 69 suppliers) which were located in the PRC.

The Group monitors a wide range of aspects for the suppliers, from product and service quality to business ethical standards. We have high expectations in the sustainability performance of our supply chain partners with the aim of achieving sustainability throughout the supply chain. Regular review and on-site inspection are carried out to ensure compliance. If any cases of noncompliance are discovered, we will terminate our cooperation promptly.

The Group strives to maintain long-lasting relationships with each supplier. Once suppliers are selected under the "Purchase Control Procedure", the Group will arrange a dedicated department to carry out strict review and control on some aspects of the supplier such as price and quality. Suppliers who fail to comply with the requirements of the Group will be removed from the supplier list.

經營實踐 層面B5:供應鏈管理

本集團深明,供應商、賣方及承包商為供應 鏈中寶貴的持份者,因為彼等負責任的商 業行為對提升本集團的卓越品質、營運效率 及良好聲譽實屬重要。我們力求與當地供應 商合作,盡可能促進當地經濟發展及加強與 供應鏈管理相關的環境風險控制。於報告期 內,本集團共有83名供應商(二零二三年:69 名供應商),均位於中國。

本集團從多方面監察供應商:從產品及服 務品質至商業道德標準。我們對供應鏈合作 夥伴的可持續發展表現寄予厚望,旨在實現 整個供應鏈的可持續發展。我們會定期檢討 及實地視察以確保合規。如發現任何違規情 況,我們將立即終止與其合作。

本集團力爭與各供應商保持長期合作關係。 根據「採購控制程序」選定供應商後,本集團 將安排專責部門對供應商的若干方面(如價 格及品質)進行嚴格審查及控制。未能符合 本集團要求的供應商將從供應商名單中剔 除。



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Aspect B6: Product responsibility

The Group attaches great importance to product quality and responsibility. The Group has implemented related policies and procedures to manage the environment maintenance service quality, as well as quality and safety of the medical devices business.

The Group continues to carry out product risk management and safety monitoring and promote product manual revision and safety evaluation based on the internal management norms and external regulatory requirements.

During the reporting period, the Group has complied with all the applicable laws and regulations regarding product and service responsibility issues in both Hong Kong and the PRC.

In addition, the Group has established a comprehensive feedback system. The data collected from its customers from time to time may consist of personal information. The Group strictly complies with the provisions of the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance, Chapter 486, Laws of Hong Kong, to ensure the personal data collected are to be treated confidently and for specific purposes. With a view to protecting the privacy, the Group also has measures designated to prevent unauthorised access to personal data.

層面B6:產品責任

本集團極其重視產品質量及產品責任。本集 團已實施相關政策及程序,以管理環境維護 服務和醫療器械業務的質量及安全。

本集團結合內部管理規範及外部監管要 求,持續開展產品風險管理和安全性監測和 推進產品說明書修訂及安全性評價工作。

於報告期內,本集團已遵守香港及中國有關 產品及服務責任事宜的所有適用法律及法 規。

此外,本集團已建立全面的反饋系統。不得 收集所得之客戶數據可能包含個人信息。 本集團嚴格遵守香港法例第486章個人資料 (私隱)條例的規定,確保對所收集之個人 資料嚴格保密且僅作特定用途。為保護客戶 私隱,本集團亦設有措施防止盜用個人資 料。





Aspect B7: Anti-corruption

The Group has always adhered to a zero-tolerance attitude towards corruption and strictly complied with laws and regulations including the Anti-Money Laundering Law of the People's Republic of China and the AntiMoney Laundering Training and Publicity System. It continues to implement various integrity and corruption mechanisms, and regularly carries out integrity education activities, in order to strengthen the legal awareness of all employees and prevent the occurrence of improper behaviours.

The Group is committed to operating with a high standard of integrity and accountability. The principle of anti-corruption is well conveyed to our employees, suppliers and customers through daily communication and training. Employees are required to declare any conflicts of interest.

In order to prevent corrupt acts of abusing power and accepting bribes, the Group continues to carry out the Anti-corruption and Anti-bribery Procedures and perform investigations to deal with and curb any possible bribery that may occur in a timely manner. We require management and procurement personnel to consciously abide by relevant laws and internal systems, and not to use their positions for personal gain. The Group ensures anti-corruption approach and prevention of nepotism through:

- 1. Conducting due diligence on potential employees, contractors and suppliers
- 2. Frequent communications from company management to all staff
- 3. Inclusion of anti-bribery provisions in the employment contracts with all workers and managers

層面B7:反貪污

Aspect B7.2 Whistle –blowing procedures

Furthermore, the Group has formulated whistle-blowing control procedure to allow its employees to report suspected cases of corruption. All reported cases are carefully classified, analysed and investigated while the information is kept confidential in order to protect the individual's privacy.

The internal monitoring department of the Group monitors the whistleblowing channels through communication with the employees and on-site inspections and checks to ensure the channels are properly functioned.

During the reporting period, the Group strictly complied with all the relevant laws and regulations, including Criminal Law of the PRC and Prevention of Bribery Ordinance in Hong Kong. No non-compliance regarding anticorruption practices, bribery or unethical behaviour was brought against the Group or its employees during the year.
