1. INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this circular is to provide you with information in respect of the resolutions to be proposed at the 2025 AGM for (i) the granting of the Repurchase Mandate to the Directors; (ii) the granting of the Issuance Mandate to the Directors; (iii) the extension of the Issuance Mandate by adding to it the number of issued Shares repurchased by the Company under the Repurchase Mandate; and (iv) the re-election of the retiring Directors.

LETTER FROM THE BOARD

2. PROPOSED GRANTING OF THE REPURCHASE AND ISSUANCE MANDATES

At the annual general meeting of the Company held on June 6, 2024, general mandates were granted to the Directors to exercise the powers of the Company to repurchase Shares and to issue new Shares respectively. Such mandates, to the extent not utilized, will lapse at the conclusion of the 2025 AGM.

In order to give the Company the flexibility to issue and repurchase Shares if and when appropriate, the following ordinary resolutions will be proposed at the 2025 AGM to approve the granting of new general mandates to the Directors:

- (a) to purchase Shares, on the Stock Exchange or on any other stock exchange recognized by the Securities and Futures Commission of Hong Kong and the Stock Exchange, not exceeding 10% of the total number of issued Shares (excluding Treasury Shares) as at the date of passing such resolution (i.e. not exceeding 139,763,370 Shares on the basis that the existing issued share capital of the Company of 1,397,633,700 Shares remains unchanged as at the date of the 2025 AGM) and the Company may hold the Shares so repurchased in treasury (the **“Repurchase Mandate”**);
- (b) to allot, issue or deal with Shares (including any sale or transfer of Treasury Shares) not exceeding 20% of the total number of issued Shares (excluding Treasury Shares) as at the date of passing such resolution (i.e. not exceeding 279,526,740 Shares on the basis that the existing issued share capital of the Company of 1,397,633,700 Shares remains unchanged as at the date of the 2025 AGM) (the **“Issuance Mandate”**); and
- (c) to extend the Issuance Mandate by adding the number of Shares repurchased by the Company pursuant to and in accordance with the Repurchase Mandate.

The Repurchase Mandate and the Issuance Mandate will continue in force until the conclusion of the next annual general meeting of the Company held after the 2025 AGM or any earlier date as referred to in the proposed ordinary resolutions contained in items 8 and 9 of the notice of the 2025 AGM as set out on pages 16 to 20 of this circular.

In accordance with the requirements of the Listing Rules, the Company shall send to Shareholders an explanatory statement containing all the information reasonably necessary to enable them to make an informed decision on whether to vote for or against the granting of the Repurchase Mandate. The explanatory statement as required by the Listing Rules in connection with the Repurchase Mandate is set out in Appendix I to this circular.

3. PROPOSED RE-ELECTION OF THE RETIRING DIRECTORS

In accordance with Article 112(a) of the existing Articles of Association, at each annual general meeting one-third of the Directors for the time being, or, if their number is not three or a multiple of three, then the number nearest to but not less than one-third, shall retire from office by rotation provided that every Director (including those appointed for a specific term) shall be subject to retirement by rotation at least once every three years. Accordingly, Mr. Guan Yihong and Ms. Cui Longyu shall retire at the 2025 AGM. Being eligible, Mr. Guan Yihong and Ms. Cui Longyu will offer themselves for re-election at the 2025 AGM.

In accordance with Article 116 of the existing Articles of Association, the Board has the power from time to time and at any time to appoint any person as a Director either to fill a casual vacancy on the Board or as an additional Director but so that the number of Directors so appointed shall not exceed the maximum number determined from time to time by the Shareholders in general meeting. Any Director appointed by the Board to fill a casual vacancy shall hold office only until the first annual general meeting of the Company after his appointment and be subject to re-election at such meeting. Any Director appointed by the Board as an addition to the existing Board shall hold office only until the first annual general meeting of the Company after his appointment and shall then be eligible for re-election. Any Director appointed under Article 116 of the existing Articles of Association shall not be taken into account in determining the Directors or the number of Directors who are to retire by rotation at an annual general meeting. Accordingly, Ms. Wang Xiaomei, who was appointed as an independent non-executive Director with effect from June 6, 2024, will hold office until the 2025 AGM and, being eligible, will offer herself for re-election.

The Nomination Committee of the Company has reviewed the structure and composition of the Board, the confirmations and disclosures given by the Directors, the qualifications, skills and experience, time commitment and contribution of the retiring Directors with reference to the nomination principles and criteria set out in the Company's Board Diversity Policy, Procedures for the Nomination Committee to Nominate to the Board a Person as Director and the Company's corporate strategy.

Besides, the Nomination Committee and the Board are satisfied with the contribution of Mr. Guan Yihong, Ms. Cui Longyu and Ms. Wang Xiaomei to the Company. Both the Nomination Committee and the Board believed that they will continue to make contribution to the Board and continue to bring valuable business experience, knowledge and professionalism to the Board for its efficient and effective functioning and diversity. The Nomination Committee and the Board therefore recommended the re-election of Mr. Guan Yihong and Ms. Cui Longyu as executive Directors, and Ms. Wang Xiaomei as an independent non-executive Director.

Pursuant to Rule 13.74 of the Listing Rules, a listed issuer shall disclose the details required under Rule 13.51(2) of the Listing Rules of any director(s) proposed to be re-elected or proposed new director in the notice or accompanying circular to its shareholders of the relevant general meeting, if such re-election or appointment is subject to shareholders' approval at that relevant general meeting. The requisite details of all retiring Directors proposed to be re-elected are set out in Appendix II to this circular.

4. 2025 AGM AND PROXY ARRANGEMENT

The notice of the 2025 AGM is set out on pages 16 to 20 of this circular. At the 2025 AGM, resolutions will be proposed to approve, inter alia, the granting of the Repurchase Mandate and the Issuance Mandate, the extension of the Issuance Mandate by the addition thereto of the number of Shares repurchased pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate, and the re-election of the retiring Directors.

Pursuant to the Listing Rules, any vote of shareholders at a general meeting must be taken by poll. Accordingly, all the proposed resolutions will be put to vote by way of poll at the 2025 AGM. An announcement on the poll results will be made by the Company after the 2025 AGM in the manner prescribed under Rule 13.39(5) of the Listing Rules.

A form of proxy for use at the 2025 AGM is enclosed with this circular and such form of proxy is also published on the websites of the Stock Exchange (www.hkexnews.hk) and the Company (www.jiumaojiu.com). Whether or not you are able to attend the 2025 AGM, please complete and sign the form of proxy in accordance with the instructions printed thereon and return it, together with the power of attorney or other authority (if any) under which it is signed or a notarially certified copy of that power of attorney or authority, to the Company's Share Registrar in Hong Kong, MUFG Corporate Markets Pty Limited, at Suite 1601, 16/F., Central Tower, 28 Queen's Road Central, Hong Kong as soon as possible but in any event not less than 48 hours before the time appointed for holding the 2025 AGM (i.e. not later than 2:30 p.m. on Wednesday, June 4, 2025) or any adjournment thereof. Completion and delivery of the form of proxy will not preclude you from attending and voting at the 2025 AGM in person if you so wish and in such event, your proxy form shall be deemed to be revoked.

5. RECOMMENDATION

The Directors consider that the granting of the Repurchase Mandate, the granting/extension of the Issuance Mandate and the re-election of the retiring Directors are in the interests of the Company, the Group and the Shareholders. Accordingly, the Directors recommend the Shareholders to vote in favour of the relevant resolutions to be proposed at the 2025 AGM.

6. GENERAL INFORMATION

The following is an explanatory statement required by the Listing Rules to be sent to Shareholders to enable them to make an informed decision on whether to vote for or against the ordinary resolution to be proposed at the 2025 AGM in relation to the granting of the Repurchase Mandate.

1. REASONS FOR REPURCHASE OF SHARES

The Directors believe that the granting of the Repurchase Mandate is in the interests of the Company, the Group and the Shareholders.

Repurchases of Shares may, depending on the market conditions and funding arrangements at the time, lead to an enhancement of the net asset value per Share and/or earnings per Share. The Directors are seeking the granting of the Repurchase Mandate to give the Company the flexibility to do so if and when appropriate. The number of Shares to be repurchased on any occasion and the price and other terms upon which the same are repurchased will be decided by the Directors at the relevant time, having regard to the circumstances then pertaining.

On the other hand, Shares bought back and held by the Company as treasury shares may be resold on the market at market prices to raise funds for the Company, or transferred or used for other purposes, subject to compliance with the applicable laws of the Cayman Islands and the Listing Rules.

2. SHARE CAPITAL

As at the Latest Practicable Date, the issued share capital of the Company comprised 1,397,633,700 Shares.

Subject to the passing of the ordinary resolution set out in item 8 of the notice of the 2025 AGM in respect of the granting of the Repurchase Mandate and on the basis that the issued share capital of the Company remains unchanged as at the date of the 2025 AGM, i.e. being 1,397,633,700 Shares, the Directors would be authorized under the Repurchase Mandate to repurchase, during the period in which the Repurchase Mandate remains in force, 139,763,370 Shares, representing 10% of the total number of Shares in issue (excluding Treasury Shares) as at the date of the 2025 AGM.

3. FUNDING OF REPURCHASES

Repurchases of Shares will be funded from the Company's internal resources, which shall be funds legally available for such purposes in accordance with the memorandum of association of the Company and the Articles of Association, the Listing Rules, the laws of the Cayman Islands and/or any other applicable laws, as the case may be.

4. IMPACT OF REPURCHASES

There might be a material adverse impact on the working capital or gearing position of the Company (as compared with the position disclosed in the audited accounts contained in the annual report of the Company for the year ended December 31, 2024) in the event that the Repurchase Mandate was to be carried out in full at any time during the proposed repurchase period. However, the Directors do not intend to exercise the Repurchase Mandate to such an extent as would, in the circumstances, have a material adverse effect on the working capital requirements of the Company or the gearing levels which in the opinion of the Directors are from time to time befitting the Company.

5. TAKEOVERS CODE

If, on the exercise of the power to repurchase Shares pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate, a Shareholder's proportionate interest in the voting rights of the Company increases, such increase will be treated as an acquisition of voting rights for the purposes of the Takeovers Code. Accordingly, a Shareholder, or a group of Shareholders acting in concert, could obtain or consolidate control of the Company and become obliged to make a mandatory offer in accordance with Rule 26 of the Takeovers Code for all the Shares not already owned by such Shareholder or group of Shareholders.

As at the Latest Practicable Date, to the best of the knowledge and belief of the Directors, GYH J Limited held 548,457,000 Shares, representing approximately 39.24% of the total issued share capital of the Company (excluding Treasury Shares). GYH J Limited is owned as to 1% (10,000 voting shares) by Mr. Guan Yihong, the chairman of the Board, an executive Director of the Group, and as to 99% (990,000 non-voting shares) by GYH LIMITED. GYH LIMITED is wholly-owned by M.T.B. CLIENTS NOMINEES LIMITED, a nominee shareholder appointed by J.P. Morgan Trust Company (Bahamas) Limited (in its capacity as the trustee of the Guan Family Trust). The Guan Family Trust is a discretionary trust established by Mr. Guan Yihong as the settlor for the benefit of his family members. Accordingly, GYH J Limited is controlled as to 100% by Mr. Guan Yihong. On the basis that (i) the issued share capital of the Company (being 1,397,633,700 Shares) remains unchanged as at the 2025 AGM; and (ii) the shareholding interests held by GYH J Limited remains unchanged immediately after the full exercise of the Repurchase Mandate, in the event that the Directors exercise in full the power to repurchase Shares under the Repurchase Mandate, the shareholding interests of GYH J Limited would be increased up to approximately 43.60% of the total issued share capital of the Company (excluding Treasury Shares). The Directors consider that such an increase in shareholdings would give rise to an obligation for GYH J Limited, Mr. Guan Yihong and his spouse, Ms. Yang Sanyin, (all being presumed parties acting in concert under the Takeovers Code) to make a mandatory offer under the Takeovers Code. The Company does not have any intention to exercise the Repurchase Mandate to such an extent as would give rise to such an obligation.

In addition, the Company has no intention to exercise the Repurchase Mandate to the effect that it will result in the public float to fall below 25% or such other minimum percentage prescribed by the Listing Rules from time to time.

6. STATUS OF REPURCHASED SHARES

The Company may cancel any repurchased Shares and/or hold them as Treasury Shares subject to market conditions and the capital management needs of the Company at the relevant time of the repurchases.

For any Treasury Shares deposited with CCASS pending resale on the Stock Exchange, the Company shall (i) procure its broker not to give any instructions to HKSCC to vote at general meetings of the Company for the Treasury Shares deposited with CCASS; and (ii) in the case of dividends or distributions, withdraw the Treasury Shares from CCASS, and either re-register them in its own name as Treasury Shares or cancel them, in each case before the record date for the dividends or distributions, or take any other measures to ensure that it will not exercise any shareholders' rights or receive any entitlements which would otherwise be suspended under the applicable laws if those Shares were registered in its own name as Treasury Shares.

7. GENERAL

None of the Directors or, to the best of their knowledge having made all reasonable enquiries, any of their respective close associates have any present intention to sell any Shares to the Company in the event that the granting of the Repurchase Mandate is approved by the Shareholders.

The Company has not been notified by any core connected persons of the Company that they have a present intention to sell any Shares to the Company, or that they have undertaken not to sell any Shares held by them to the Company in the event that the granting of the Repurchase Mandate is approved by the Shareholders.

The Directors will exercise the power of the Company to make repurchases of Shares pursuant to the Repurchase Mandate in accordance with the Listing Rules and the applicable laws of the Cayman Islands.

The Company has confirmed that neither the explanatory statement nor the proposed share repurchase has any unusual features.

9. REPURCHASES OF SHARES MADE BY THE COMPANY

No repurchase of Shares has been made by the Company during the previous 6 months prior to the Latest Practicable Date (whether on the Stock Exchange or otherwise).

Pursuant to the Listing Rules, the details of the Directors, who will retire and offer themselves for re-election at the 2025 AGM according to the Articles of Association, are provided below.

(1) Mr. Guan Yihong

Position and experience

Mr. Guan Yihong (“Mr. Guan”), aged 55, is an executive Director and the chairman of the Board. He is also our controlling shareholder. He is responsible for formulating the overall development strategies and business plans of our Company and overseeing the management and strategic development of our Company. Mr. Guan started his first noodle restaurant in Haikou, Hainan Province in 1995 and founded our Group in 2005. Mr. Guan has extensive experience in the catering industry. He has been the chief executive officer of our Company’s subsidiary, Guangzhou Jiumaojiu since August 2005. He also served as chairman of the board of Guangzhou Jiumaojiu from August 2005 to May 2019 and has been the executive director of Guangzhou Jiumaojiu since May 2019. Mr. Guan received his bachelor’s degree in business management from Tianjin Institute of Textile Science and Technology (天津紡織工學院) (now known as Tianjin Polytechnic University (天津工業大學)) in 1990.

Mr. Guan has not held other directorships in the last three years in public companies the securities of which are listed on any securities market in Hong Kong or overseas.

Length of service and director’s emoluments

Pursuant to the service agreement entered into between Mr. Guan and the Company, his initial term of office is 3 years from December 6, 2019, and the service agreement was renewed with the same terms. He is also subject to retirement and re-election at annual general meeting of the Company in accordance with the Articles of Association.

Pursuant to the said service agreement, Mr. Guan is entitled to receive an annual salary of RMB2,770,000. The emoluments of Mr. Guan are determined by the Board by reference to his performance, experience and responsibilities and the Company’s remuneration policy.

Relationships

Mr. Guan is the sole director and a shareholder of GYH J Limited (a controlling Shareholder).

Save as disclosed above and in the immediately following “Interests in Shares”, Mr. Guan does not have any relationships with other directors, senior management, substantial shareholders, or controlling shareholders of the Company.

Interests in Shares

As far as the Directors are aware, as at the Latest Practicable Date, Mr. Guan personally held 1,150,000 share options of the Company attaching thereto the rights to subscribe for 1,150,000 Shares, representing approximately 0.08% of the issued share capital of the Company. He was deemed to be interested in 548,457,000 Shares, representing approximately 39.24% of the issued share capital of the Company, held by GYH J Limited. GYH J Limited is controlled as to 100% by Mr. Guan. Save as disclosed above, Mr. Guan was not interested or deemed to be interested in any Shares or underlying Shares of the Company or its associated corporations pursuant to Part XV of the SFO.

Other information and matters that need to be disclosed or brought to the attention of the Shareholders
