IF YOU WISH TO VOTE AGAINST THE RESOLUTIONS, TICK THE APPROPRIATE BOXES MARKED “AGAINST”.** Failure to tick any or all the boxes will entitle your proxy to cast his/her votes at his/her discretion. Your proxy will also be entitled to vote at his/her discretion on any resolution properly put to the Meeting.
5. Any shareholder entitled to attend and vote at the Meeting is entitled to appoint one or more proxies to attend and vote in his/her stead. A proxy need not be a shareholder of the Company.
6. To be valid, this form of proxy together with the power of attorney or other authority (if any) under which it is signed, or a notarially certified copy thereof, shall be lodged at the Company's Hong Kong branch share registrar, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, at 17M Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong not less than 48 hours before the time for holding the Meeting or any adjournment thereof.
7. This form of proxy must be signed by you or your attorney duly authorized in writing or, in the case of a corporation, must be either executed under its seal or under the hand of an officer, attorney or other person duly authorized to sign the same.
8. In the case of joint holders of any shares, any one of such joint holders may vote at the above Meeting, either personally or by proxy, in respect of such shares as if he were solely entitled thereto. However, if more than one of such joint holders are present at the Meeting, either personally or by proxy, the vote of the joint holder whose name stands first in the Register of Members and who tenders a vote, whether in person or by proxy, will be accepted to the exclusion of the votes of the other joint holder(s).
9. On a poll, every shareholder present in person or by proxy shall be entitled to one vote for each share registered in his/her name. The result of such poll shall be deemed to be the resolution of the Meeting at which the poll was so taken.
10. Completion and delivery of this form of proxy will not preclude you from attending and voting at the Meeting if you so wish. In such event, the instrument appointing a proxy shall be deemed to be revoked.

PERSONAL INFORMATION COLLECTION STATEMENT

“Personal Data” in this statement has the same meaning as “personal data” in the Personal Data (Privacy) Ordinance, Cap 486 (PDPO), which will include your and your appointed proxy's name and mailing address and any another personal data required to be provided. By providing your appointed proxy's Personal Data, you hereby confirm that you have obtained the consent of your appointed proxy to provide their Personal Data to the Company and Its Registrars. The Personal Data provided by you may be used in connection with processing your appointment of proxy at the Company's AGM and instructions. Your supply of the Personal Data to the Company and/or its Registrars is on a voluntary basis. However, we may not be able to effect the appointment of your proxy and instructions unless you provide us with the Personal Data. Your and your appointed proxy's Personal Data will be transferred to the Registrars' agents, contractors or third-party service providers who/which offer administrative, telecommunications, computer, payment or other data processing services to the Registrars in connection with the operation of their business for the above purposes. The Company and its Registrars may also transfer your and your appointed proxy's Personal Data if it is required to do so by law or in response to requests from law enforcement agencies or regulatory authorities. The Personal Data collected in this form of proxy will be retained for such period as may be necessary for any of the above purposes and its directly related purposes such as for record, verification and notification purposes. You and your appointed proxy have the right to request access to, correction and/or erasure of the respective Personal Data in accordance with the provisions of the PDPO, and any other data protection law as applicable.
