The Board considers that the increase in the operating results of the Group as compared with the same period in 2024 is mainly due to the increase in revenue from the securities brokerage business and proprietary investment business.

The information contained in this announcement is only based on the unaudited consolidated management accounts of the Group for the six months ended 30 June 2025, which has not been reviewed or audited by the auditors of the Company nor approved by the audit committee of the Company.
