**In the First Nine Months of 2025,  
Net Generation of Subsidiary Power Plants Increased by 4.2%,  
among which Subsidiary Wind Farms Increased by 10.3%,  
Photovoltaic Power Plants Increased by 35.1%**

Total net generation of subsidiary power plants in September 2025 decreased by 8.0% year on year to 17,152,768 MWh, among which, due to weather conditions and power plant maintenance, subsidiary thermal plants decreased by 9.2% year on year to 12,980,739 MWh; due to the lowered wind speed, subsidiary wind farms decreased by 13.4% year on year to 3,081,795 MWh; subsidiary photovoltaic power plants increased by 49.7% year on year to 922,421 MWh.

Total net generation of subsidiary power plants for the first nine months of 2025 increased by 4.2% year on year to 160,841,703 MWh, among which, subsidiary thermal plants increased by 0.9% year on year to 117,033,963 MWh, subsidiary wind farms increased by 10.3% year on year to 35,353,951 MWh, subsidiary photovoltaic power plants increased by 35.1% year on year to 7,088,587 MWh.
