**In the First Eleven Months of 2025,
Net Generation of Subsidiary Power Plants Increased by 7.1%,
among which Subsidiary Wind Farms Increased by 15.8%,
Photovoltaic Power Plants Increased by 55.4%**

Total net generation of subsidiary power plants in November 2025 increased by 8.6% year on year to 18,866,666 MWh, among which, subsidiary wind farms increased by 29.5% year on year to 5,260,109 MWh; subsidiary photovoltaic power plants increased by 71.2% year on year to 1,020,094 MWh.

Total net generation of subsidiary power plants for the first eleven months of 2025 increased by 7.1% year on year to 204,885,875 MWh, among which, subsidiary wind farms increased by 15.8% year on year to 48,340,837 MWh, subsidiary photovoltaic power plants increased by 55.4% year on year to 12,069,023 MWh.
