**In the First Two Months of 2026,
Net Generation of Subsidiary Power Plants Increased by 16.4%,
among which Subsidiary Wind Farms Increased by 7.3%,
Photovoltaic Plants Increased by 55.9%**

Total net generation of subsidiary power plants in February 2026 increased by 2.3% year on year to 16,039,423 MWh, among which, subsidiary wind farms increased by 7.4% year on year to 4,519,772 MWh, subsidiary photovoltaic plants increased by 38.7% year on year to 987,575 MWh.

Total net generation of subsidiary power plants for the first two months of 2026 increased by 16.4% year on year to 39,828,212 MWh, among which, subsidiary wind farms increased by 7.3% year on year to 9,449,754 MWh, subsidiary photovoltaic power plants increased by 55.9% year on year to 1,454,160 MWh.
