among which Subsidiary Wind Farms Decreased by 2.0%,
Photovoltaic Plants Increased by 44.7%**

Total net generation of subsidiary power plants in March 2026 increased by 16.2% year on year to 20,809,212 MWh, among which, subsidiary wind farms decreased by 16.9% year on year to 4,552,945 MWh due to the decrease in wind speed, subsidiary photovoltaic plants increased by 26.9% year on year to 1,154,560 MWh.

Total net generation of subsidiary power plants for the first three months of 2026 increased by 16.3% year on year to 60,637,424 MWh, among which, subsidiary wind farms decreased by 2.0% year on year to 14,002,698 MWh due to the decrease in wind speed; subsidiary photovoltaic power plants increased by 44.7% year on year to 3,421,521 MWh.
