If a black rainstorm warning or a tropical cyclone warning signal number 8 or above is hoisted at 12:00 noon or any time after 12:00 noon on 24 June 2026, the annual general meeting will not be held on that day but will be held at the same time and place on the first Business Day after 24 June 2026 instead.
6. **IMPORTANT: IF YOU WISH TO VOTE FOR A RESOLUTION, PLEASE PLACE A “✓” IN THE RELEVANT BOX MARKED “FOR”. IF YOU WISH TO VOTE AGAINST A RESOLUTION, PLEASE PLACE A “✓” IN THE RELEVANT BOX MARKED “AGAINST”.** In the absence of such indication, your proxy will entitle to cast his vote at his discretion. Your proxy will also be entitled to vote at his discretion on any resolution properly put to the meeting other than those referred to in the notice convening this meeting.
7. This form of proxy must be signed by you or your attorney duly authorised in writing or, in the case of a corporation, must be either under its common seal or under the hand of an officer, attorney or other person duly authorised to sign.

In the case of joint holders of a share, the vote of the senior who tenders a vote, whether in person or by proxy, shall be accepted to the exclusion of the votes of the other joint holders and for this purpose, seniority shall be determined by the order in which the names stand in the register in respect of the joint holding.
9. To be valid, this form of proxy together with the power of attorney or other authority (if any) under which it is signed or a notarially certified copy thereof, must be deposited at the share registrar of the Company, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited at 17M Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen’s Road East, Wan Chai, Hong Kong not less than 48 hours before the time appointed for holding the meeting (i.e. no later than 3:00 p.m. on 22 June 2026 (Hong Kong time)) or not less than 48 hours before the time appointed for any adjournment thereof.
10. Any alteration made to this form of proxy must be initialled by the person who signs it.
11. Completion and deposit of the form of proxy will not preclude you from attending and voting at the annual general meeting if you so wish.

PERSONAL INFORMATION COLLECTION STATEMENT

- (iv) You have the right to request access to and/or correction of your Personal Data in accordance with the provisions of the PDPO.
