**In the First Five Months of 2026,
Net Generation of Subsidiary Power Plants Increased by 14.4%,
among which Subsidiary Wind Farms Decreased by 2.4%,
Photovoltaic Plants Increased by 43.9%**

Total net generation of subsidiary power plants in May 2026 increased by 12.2% year on year to 20,110,013 MWh, among which, subsidiary wind farms decreased by 3.3% year on year to 4,882,497 MWh due to the decrease in wind speed, subsidiary photovoltaic plants increased by 39.6% year on year to 1,593,551 MWh.

Total net generation of subsidiary power plants for the first five months of 2026 increased by 14.4% year on year to 101,083,121 MWh, among which, subsidiary wind farms decreased by 2.4% year on year to 23,913,866 MWh due to the decrease in wind speed, subsidiary photovoltaic power plants increased by 43.9% year on year to 6,594,258 MWh.
