The total number of Shares entitling the Shareholders to attend and vote for or against the resolutions at the AGM was 44,223,990,583 Shares (of which 8,726,234,000 were H Shares and 35,497,756,583 were A Shares), which is the total number of issued Shares of the Company as at the date of the AGM. No Shareholders were required to abstain from voting on the resolutions under the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited (the “**Hong Kong Listing Rules**”). There were no Shares entitling the holders to attend the meeting and abstain from voting in favour of the resolutions under Rule 13.40 of the Hong Kong Listing Rules. None of the Shareholders have stated their intention in the Circular to vote against or to abstain from voting on the resolutions proposed at the AGM. Shareholders and authorised proxies holding an aggregate of 36,500,628,977 Shares were present at the AGM. The holding of the AGM was in compliance with the Company Law and the Articles of Association. In accordance with the Hong Kong Listing Rules, the Company’s H Share registrar, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, was the scrutineer at the AGM.

The Company currently has 11 Directors, 11 of whom were present at the AGM.

RECOMMENDATION OF FINAL DIVIDEND

The resolution in relation to the profit distribution plan for the year 2025 was duly approved by Shareholders at the AGM. For the full context of the resolution, please refer to the Circular.

The Company will distribute the final dividend for the year 2025 on or around Friday, 31 July 2026 to Shareholders whose names were listed on the register of members of the Company on Thursday, 9 July 2026. The announced final dividend for the year 2025 is denominated in RMB, which is RMB1.45 per 10 Shares (inclusive of tax), amounting to a total of RMB6,412 million.

Final dividend on H Shares will be paid in Hong Kong dollar (Hong Kong Stock Connect Accounts will be paid in RMB). The applicable exchange rate is HK\$1 = RMB0.8695775, being the average middle exchange rate of Hong Kong dollar to Renminbi on the interbank foreign exchange market as announced on the China Foreign Exchange Trade System under the authorisation of the People's Bank of China for the week prior to the date on which the dividend is declared at the AGM.

For the purpose of determining the entitlement of the holders of H Shares to the final dividend for the year 2025, the H Share register of members of the Company will be closed from Monday, 6 July 2026 to Thursday, 9 July 2026 (both days inclusive), during which period no transfer of H Shares will be registered. In order to be entitled to the final dividend for the year 2025, holders of H Shares must deposit the share certificates together with the transfer documents at the Company's H Share registrar, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, at Shops 1712-1716, 17th Floor, Hopewell Centre, 183 Queen's Road East, Wanchai, Hong Kong, before 4:30 p.m. on Friday, 3 July 2026.
