INSIDE INFORMATION OPERATION BRIEFINGS FOR THE SECOND QUARTER OF 2026

This announcement is made by CGN Power Co., Ltd.* (the “**Company**”, together with its subsidiaries, collectively, the “**Group**”) pursuant to Rule 13.09 of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited and the Inside Information Provisions under Part XIVA of the Securities and Futures Ordinance (Chapter 571 of The Laws of Hong Kong).

POWER GENERATION AND ON-GRID POWER GENERATION

The board of directors (the “**Board**”) of the Company announces that, based on the statistics of the Company, the total power generation of nuclear power generating units operated and managed by the Group from January to June 2026 amounted to approximately 117,766.09 GWh, representing a year-on-year decrease of 2.12%. The total commercial on-grid power generation amounted to approximately 109,597.06 GWh, representing a year-on-year decrease of 3.32%.

Details of the power generation and on-grid power generation from January to June 2026 are as follows:

This announcement also contains a brief operation review of the Company for the second quarter of 2026 as follows:

STATUS OF OPERATION

Units in operation

On April 19, 2026, Huizhou Unit 1 was put into commercial operation.

On April 29, 2026, Cangnan Unit 1 was put into commercial operation.

In the second quarter of 2026, the Group completed, as scheduled, three annual refuelling outages and two ten-year outages.

As at June 30, 2026, the Group had completed, as scheduled, seven annual refuelling outages (including one annual refuelling outage carried over from the previous year) and four ten-year refuelling outages.

In the third quarter of 2026, the Group plans to conduct three annual refuelling outages and two ten-year outages.

Units under construction

As at June 30, 2026, the Group managed a total of 18 nuclear power generating units under construction, which were from the subsidiaries of the Company, among which, three were in the commissioning phase, two were in the equipment installation phase, seven were in the civil construction phase, and six were in the FCD preparation phase. Progress of construction for the units under construction is detailed in the table below:

MISCELLANEOUS

The Company declared to all shareholders a final dividend of RMB0.086 per share (tax inclusive) for the year ended December 31, 2025. As the Company's A-share convertible corporate bonds have commenced conversion, resulting in changes to the Company's share capital, the Company will distribute the dividend based on the principle of maintaining the dividend per share unchanged while adjusting the total cash dividend amount accordingly. The above matter was approved at the 2025 Annual General Meeting held on May 20, 2026 and is expected to be paid on July 10, 2026. For details, please refer to the Company's announcements dated May 20, 2026 and July 2, 2026.

On June 18, 2026, the Company's first Extraordinary General Meeting of 2026 approved the acquisition by the Company from China General Nuclear Power Corporation (the Company's controlling shareholder) of 46% equity interest in CGN Cangnan Nuclear Power Co., Ltd. and 51% equity interest in CGN Cangnan No. 2 Nuclear Power Co., Ltd. held by it. The transaction was completed on June 30, 2026, and the aforementioned companies have become subsidiaries of the Company. For details, please refer to the Company's announcements dated June 18, 2026 and June 30, 2026.
