When a member appoints more than one proxy, the appointment shall be invalid unless he/she specifies the proportions of his/her shareholdings to be represented by each proxy. In case of a vote taken by a show of hands, the first named proxy shall vote on your behalf. A proxy may but need not be a member of the Company, but must attend the meeting in person to represent you.
