Total net generation of subsidiary power plants in June 2026 increased by 5.1% year on year to 19,353,280 MWh, among which, subsidiary wind farms decreased by 8.5% year on year to 3,631,777 MWh due to the decrease in wind speed, subsidiary photovoltaic power plants increased by 38.8% year on year to 1,662,848 MWh.

Total net generation of subsidiary power plants for the first six months of 2026 increased by 12.8% year on year to 120,436,401 MWh, among which, subsidiary wind farms decreased by 3.2% year on year to 27,545,642 MWh due to the decrease in wind speed, subsidiary photovoltaic power plants increased by 42.8% year on year to 8,257,107 MWh.
