**In the First Seven Months of 2026,
Net Generation of Subsidiary Power Plants Increased by 10.9%,
among which Subsidiary Wind Farms Decreased by 1.2%,
Photovoltaic Power Plants Increased by 37.5%**

Total net generation of subsidiary power plants in July 2026 increased by 1.9% year on year to 22,809,147 MWh, among which, subsidiary wind farms increased by 14.0% year on year to 4,474,362 MWh, subsidiary photovoltaic power plants increased by 18.0% year on year to 1,885,527 MWh.

Total net generation of subsidiary power plants for the first seven months of 2026 increased by 10.9% year on year to 143,245,549 MWh, among which, subsidiary wind farms decreased by 1.2% year on year to 32,020,004 MWh due to the decrease in wind speed, subsidiary photovoltaic power plants increased by 37.5% year on year to 10,142,634 MWh.
