Shareholders who wish to be notified when HKEX publishes its Corporate Communications on the HKEX Group website may register for the News Alerts service in the Market Data section of the HKEX Market website (www.hkex.com.hk). You may submit request for receiving email notification of the publication by liaising with your Intermediary(ies) (Note 3) and providing the intermediary(ies) with your email address. The email address provided by you must be valid and functional.

Request for printed or electronic version of Corporate Communication(s)

Please note that your request, if any, for receiving future Corporate Communications of HKEX in printed form will only be valid from the date of your request and until the time when HKEX publishes its next annual report in the following year, unless your instruction is earlier revoked or superseded.

Please complete and submit the Online Request Form via scanning the QR code above or the Request Form (Note 4) should you wish to:

- (a) request for printed version of HKEX's future Corporate Communications, or amend or cancel your prior request; or
- (b) receive a printed or electronic version of the HKEX 2026 Interim Report or specific Corporate Communication(s) after they have encountered difficulty in accessing the document(s) electronically via the HKEX Group website or the HKEXnews website.

You may at any time make, amend or cancel your request for printed version of future Corporate Communications with not less than seven days' notice in writing to HKEX's registrar, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited ("Registrar"), by submitting the Online Request Form or the Request Form. HKEX will promptly upon your request send the printed or electronic version to him/her free of charge.

Non-registered shareholder means such person or company whose HKEX shares are held in the Central Clearing and Settlement System (CCASS) and who has notified HKEX from time to time through Hong Kong Securities Clearing Company Limited to receive Corporate Communications. If you have sold or transferred your shares in HKEX, please disregard this letter.

Corporate Communications refer to any documents issued or to be issued by HKEX for the information or action of holders of any of its securities or the investing public, including, but not limited to, the directors' report, the annual accounts together with a copy of the auditor's report, the interim report, a notice of meeting, a listing document, a circular and a proxy form.
3. Intermediary(ies) refer(s) to the bank(s), broker(s), custodian(s), nominee(s) or HKSCC Nominees Limited through which your HKEX shares are held.
