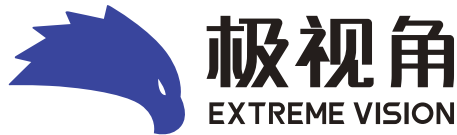

VOLUNTARY ANNOUNCEMENT STRATEGIC COOPERATION AGREEMENTS

This is a voluntary announcement made by Shandong Extreme Vision Technology Co., Ltd.* (the “**Company**”, together with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”) to provide the shareholders of the Company and potential investors an update on the latest business development of the Group.

The board of directors (the “**Board**”) of the Company is pleased to announce that the Company entered into strategic cooperation agreements with GitLab Information Technology (Hubei) Co., Ltd. (極狐信息技術(湖北)有限公司) (“**GitLab**”) on August 20, 2026 (the “**GitLab Strategic Cooperation Agreement**”), and Best Management Consulting Co., Ltd.* (百思特管理諮詢有限公司) (“**Best Management Consulting**”) on August 28, 2026 (the “**Best Management Consulting Strategic Cooperation Agreement**”, together with the GitLab Strategic Cooperation Agreement, the “**Strategic Cooperation Agreements**”).

SUMMARY OF THE GITLAB STRATEGIC COOPERATION AGREEMENT

The directors of the Company (the “**Directors**”) are of the view that the GitLab Strategic Cooperation Agreement marks a further deepening of the Company’s strategic positioning in enterprise-level AI agent and Token services. By leveraging GitLab’s extensive developer and enterprise customer ecosystem, the cooperation represents a milestone step towards commercialising the Company’s vision-language large model, developing a Token-based revenue model for its self-developed large models and AI agent solutions, and establishing a standardised and replicable Token service offering.

Pursuant to the GitLab Strategic Cooperation Agreement, the parties agreed to carry out extensive and in-depth cooperation in the following areas:

1. **Platform Technology Integration & Token Service Access:** Integrate the Company's vision-language large model with GitLab's development and operations platforms in the form of a Token service with a view to empowering enterprise software R&D processes with AI vision capabilities. Specific areas of exploration include:
 - a. Integrating GitLab's self-developed platform with the Company's model training and inference platform and application development platform, and researching technical solutions for providing enterprise customers with large-model application development and Token call services that cover the entire process of "R&D — Production — Sales — Service — Management"; and
 - b. After validating feasibility in benchmark scenarios, further exploring standardised cooperation pathways and SaaS-based business models, so as to form a replicable cooperation model of "R&D toolchain integrated with visual intelligence";
2. **AI Agent Ecosystem Alliance:** Jointly launch the "AI Agent Development Alliance" as a brand vehicle for ecosystem collaboration, integrating respective developer communities alongside industry partners, and adopt the Forward Deployed Engineer ("FDE") service model as the core operating mechanism to translate real business problems into actionable AI engineering solutions, thereby establishing a value co-creation cycle that accelerates talent development, strengthens brand synergy, and builds a foundation for future strategic cooperation; and
3. **Developer Community & Brand Synergy:** Jointly establish a dynamic developer community through official platform designations and exclusive benefit integrations etc., while simultaneously undertaking brand synergy and joint publication efforts, including joint PR releases and continuous industry content output.

SUMMARY OF THE BEST MANAGEMENT CONSULTING STRATEGIC COOPERATION AGREEMENT

The Directors are of the view that the Best Management Consulting Strategic Cooperation Agreement will enable the Company to draw on the nearly two decades' experience accumulated by Best Management Consulting in the enterprise consulting field to jointly establish and cultivate combined "business consulting and technology" FDE teams, so as to support the implementation of enterprise-level AI large model solutions on a large scale and to address the shortage of FDE talent in the industry. Furthermore, the Company can utilise the cooperation with Best Management Consulting to broaden its customer channels and strengthen the Company's competitiveness and brand recognition in the enterprise-level AI service market.

Pursuant to the Best Management Consulting Strategic Cooperation Agreement, the parties agreed to carry out comprehensive cooperation in the following areas:

1. **Joint Solutions & Service Development:** Jointly build FDE teams for developing comprehensive solution packages that integrate management consulting with technology platforms, focusing on the digital transformation and intelligent upgrading needs of enterprise clients;
2. **Joint Marketing for Business Expansion:** Deploy joint consultant-engineer teams for co-sales efforts, including jointly participating in market events, co-publishing industry reports and case studies, and providing AI transformation training; and
3. **Talent & Knowledge Exchange:** Conduct mutual cross-training between AI engineers and management consultants on FDE methodologies for the nurturing of all-rounded FDE talent teams, and explore future joint venture opportunities.
