The Collaboration enables the Group to partner with an optical research team of internationally leading standards, to support the application of advanced optical technologies in the field of visual products, and to continuously promote the research, development and launch of new-generation visual products. Meanwhile, the Collaboration provides the Company and Zhejiang University with the joint ownership of the intellectual property rights arising from the relevant new technological achievements, thereby strengthening the core competitiveness of the Group in the automotive display sector.

In view of the above, the Board is of the view that the Collaboration will advance the research and development of the principal products of the Group and is expected to enhance the Group's ability to lead in advanced technologies in the visual sector.

The Collaboration does not constitute a notifiable transaction or connected transaction under Chapter 14 or Chapter 14A of the Rules Governing the Listing of Securities on The Stock Exchange of Hong Kong Limited.

The Group is committed to the research and development (“**R&D**”) of HUD solutions and adheres to the core philosophy of “user experience design”. At the solution definition stage, the Group works closely with OEMs to co-develop new vehicle models featuring deeper human-vehicle interaction and enhanced intelligent driving experiences.
