POLL RESULTS OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING HELD ON 21 SEPTEMBER 2026 AND RETIREMENT OF INDEPENDENT NON-EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AND NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THE LISTING RULES

Reference is made to the circular (the “**Circular**”) of Culturecom Holdings Limited (the “**Company**”) and the notice (the “**Notice**”) of the annual general meeting both dated 28 August 2026 in relation to the annual general meeting (the “**AGM**”) of the Company held on 21 September 2026. Unless the context requires otherwise, capitalized terms used in this announcement shall have the same meanings as those defined in the Circular.

POLL RESULTS OF THE AGM

The Board is pleased to announce that all the proposed resolutions, except for the Resolution numbered 3(iii), as set out in the Notice (the “**Resolutions**”) were duly passed by the Shareholders by way of poll at the AGM.

The poll results in respect of the Resolutions at the AGM were as follows:

Note: The description of the Resolutions above is by way of summary only, the full text of which are set out in the Notice.

As more than 50% of the votes were cast in favour of each of the Resolutions numbered 1 to 7, except for the Resolution numbered 3(iii), of the AGM, all the Resolutions save as the Resolution numbered 3(iii) were duly passed as ordinary resolutions of the Company.

As at the date of the AGM, a total of 1,734,075,788 Shares were in issue, which entitled the Shareholders to attend and vote for or against the Resolutions at the AGM. There were no Shares entitling the Shareholders to attend the AGM and abstain from voting in favour of the Resolutions at the AGM as set out in Rule 13.40 of the Listing Rules.

No Shareholders were required under the Listing Rules to abstain from voting. No Shareholders had stated their intention in the Circular to vote against or to abstain from voting on any of the Resolutions at the AGM.

All Directors attended the AGM in person or by way of electronic means.

The Company's branch share registrar in Hong Kong, Computershare Hong Kong Investor Services Limited, acted as the scrutineer for the purpose of vote-taking at the AGM.

RETIREMENT OF INDEPENDENT NON-EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AND NON-COMPLIANCE WITH THE LISTING RULES

Following the poll results set out above, Ms. Sheng Haiyuan retired as independent non-executive Director with effect from 21 September 2026. The Board then comprises of four Directors, of which two are executive Directors and two are independent non-executive Directors. The Company does not comply with the following requirements under the Listing Rules:

- (1) the requirement under Rule 3.10(1) of the Listing Rules which stipulates that the board must include at least three independent non-executive directors;
- (2) the requirement under Rule 3.21 of the Listing Rules which stipulates that the audit committee must comprise a minimum of three members;
- (3) the requirement under Rule 13.92 of the Listing Rules which stipulates that the board must have directors of different genders; and

- (4) the requirement under B.3.5 of the corporate governance code (the “**CG Code**”) as set out in Appendix C1 of the Listing Rules which stipulates that the listed issuer must appoint at least one director of a different gender to the nomination committee.

The Board will use its best endeavors to identify a suitable female candidate for appointment as a Director within three months from the date of this announcement in order to ensure the compliance with the Listing Rules. Further announcement will be made by the Company as and when appropriate.

The Board is not aware of any matters relating to her retirement that need to be brought to the attention of the Shareholders and the Stock Exchange. The Board would like to express its sincere gratitude to Ms. Sheng for her valuable contribution to the Company and the Board during her tenure of office.
